

Members Covid 19 Operational Plan

During the recovery phase, it is important to understand that this is NOT business as usual, and that the directives and advice outlined in this document will remain in place until the risk is effectively controlled, depending upon how the situation of COVID-19 evolves. It is critical that everyone continues to adhere to these guidelines so that we maintain the excellent mitigation work that we have come to see in New Brunswick so far. This is keeping our communities and loved ones safe. (From Office of the Chief Medical Officer of Health)

- Members and staff must always maintain 6' of distance from each other as set out by the guidelines. If this can't be met, then the proper protective measures such as wearing masks or gloves must be worn.
- There will be no events, gatherings, no sitting, BBQ or cooking, congregating or groups aloud on the dock, social area or shack patio. There will be no socializing or hosting friends or other members on boats outside of immediate members household.
- Only boat club members and immediate households are allowed on the dock /boats. No friends, guests, extended family including your chosen outside bubbles are aloud. Just your first mate and immediate family who live at the same address as you.
- No loading or unloading of guests at the dock
- Mechanical and marine services will be permitted on the dock but must contact the shack and arrange a date and time. The 3rd party must sign in and out at the shack.
- When entering and exiting the marina members must go directly to and from their boats no stopping to socialize. Everyone should take notice of who is on the dock/ramp and try to come and go when the dock is free of people to maintain the 6' rule.
- It has been strongly recommended from the department of public health and safety to wear a non-medical mask when out in public. We are supporting this and recommend when coming and going on the dock that you use a non-medical mask when walking on the docks and they are required when distancing measures cannot be met due to tasks.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be set up at the shack and foot of the ramp for members use. Garbage cans will be placed for disposal of paper towel/ wipes.
- Under no circumstances should members garbage or recyclables be left on the dock. Please bring these up to the dumpster or home for proper disposal or recycling.

- Pump out will be available but you must make arrangements with the dock attendant and she or he will meet you to pump and sanitize used equipment after use.
- Ice will be available, but we are not accepting cash during the pandemic. Electronic payments or ice tabs will be available at the shack which must be signed for by the member.
- Carts will available and will be sanitized regularly but must be brought back to the shack immediately after use.

Throughout the summer there will be inspections from the dept of health as well as we know we are in the public eye, so failure to meet and follow these rules could result in large fines to the club and closure of the marina for the summer. With this in mind, we are taking a no-nonsense stance on these rules, they are for your safety and for the club. **If rules are not followed this could result in termination of membership and immediate dismissal from the CCBC.**

We know these rules are invasive and are out of the norm for our club and that we pride ourselves on our friendly and positive environment. We hope things will change for the better and we can get back to our norm. We will keep you updated on any changes made and truly appreciate your support and cooperation at keeping our club, co members and friends safe by following the rules.
