Mark 3:7-12

I. Jesus and his disciples <u>travelled</u> to a secluded place.

**Mark 3:7 "Jesus withdrew with his disciples to the lake, and a large crowd from Galilee followed."

John 6:66 "From this time many of His disciples turned back and no longer followed Him."

II. Jesus and his disciples were <u>tracked</u> by a large crowd.

**Mark 3:7b "... and a large crowd from Galilee followed."

**Mark 3:8 "When they heard about all he was doing, many people came to him from Judea, Jerusalem, Idumea, and the regions across the Jordan and around Tyre and Sidon."

**Mark 3:9 "Because of the crowd He told His disciples to have a small boat ready for him, to keep the people from crowding him."

III. Jesus <u>transformed</u> the sick and demonically controlled people.

A. Jesus healed people who had <u>diseases</u>.

**Mark 3:10 "For He had healed many, so that those with diseases were pushing forward to touch Him."

Mark 6:56 "And wherever He went – into villages, towns or countryside – they placed the sick in the marketplaces. They begged Him to let them touch even the edge of His cloak, and all who touched Him were healed."

Luke 8:44 "She came up behind Him and touched the edge of His cloak, and immediately her bleeding stopped."

B. Jesus cast out demons.

- **Mark 3:11 "Whenever the evil spirits saw Him, they fell down before him and cried out, "You are the Son of God."
- James 2:19 "You believe that there is one God. Good! Even the demons believe that and shudder."
- **Mark 3:12 "But He gave them strict orders not to tell who He was."
- Acts 16:17b "... these are servants of the Most High God, who are telling you the way to be saved."
- Acts 16:18 "She kept this up for many days. Finally, Paul became so troubled that he turned around and said to the spirit, "In the name of Jesus Christ I command you to come out of her!" At that moment the spirit left her."
- **Mark 1:34** "And Jesus healed many who had various diseases. He also drove out many demons, but He would not let the demons speak because they knew who he was."
- **Matthew 8:16** "When evening came, many who were demon-possessed were brought to Him, and He drove out the spirits with a word and healed all the sick."
- I Corinthians 10:20 "No, but the sacrifices of pagans are offered to demons, not to God, and I do not want you to be participants with demons."
- Acts 19:18 "Many of those who believed now came and openly confessed their evil deeds. ^[19] "A number who had practiced sorcery brought their scrolls together and burned them publicly. When they calculated the value of the scrolls, the total came to fifty thousand drachmas."

Here are some truths about serving!

A. Serving the Lord will not always be <u>convenient</u>. So, be <u>available!</u>

Philippians 2:4 "Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others."

B. Serving the Lord comes with a <u>cost</u>. So, be <u>giving!</u>

Acts 16:15 "When she and the members of her household were baptized, she invited us to her home. "If you consider me a believer in the Lord," she said, "come and stay at my house." And she persuaded us."

C. Serving the Lord pushes us out of our <u>comfort</u> zone. So, step out <u>by faith</u> and serve!

Philippians 4:13 "I can do everything through Him who gives me strength."

James 1:5 "If any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault and it will be given to him."

Philippians 4:19 "And my God will meet all your needs according to His glorious riches in Christ Jesus."

Luke 1:37 "For nothing is impossible with God."

D. Serving the Lord can <u>change</u> the life of those you minister too. Ask the Lord <u>to use</u> you!
