A. Jesus spoke to His disciples about peace.

John 14:1 “Do not let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God; trust also in me.”

Luke 9:22 “And He said “The Son of Man must suffer many things and be rejected by the elders, the chief priests and the teachers of the law, and He must be killed and on the third day be raised to life.”

Luke 18:31 “Jesus took the Twelve aside and told them, “We are going up to Jerusalem, and everything that is written by the prophets about the Son of Man will be fulfilled. [32] He will be handed over to the Gentiles. They will mock Him, insult Him, spit on Him, flog Him and kill Him. [33] On the third day He will rise again.”

Matthew 26:33 “Peter replied “Even if all fall away on account of you, I never will.”

Matthew 26:34 “I tell you the truth,” Jesus answered, “This very night before the rooster crows, you will disown me three times.”

John 14:1b “... Trust in God^[a]; trust also in me.”

1. The dead believers will rise first.

I Thessalonians 4:16 “For the LORD Himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first.”

I Corinthians 15:42 “So will it be with the resurrection of the dead. The body that is sown is perishable, it is raised imperishable.”

I Corinthians 15:43 “It is sown in dishonor, it is raised in glory; it is sown in weakness, it is raised in power.”

I Corinthians 15:44 “It is sown a natural body, it is raised a spiritual body.”

2. The living believers will be caught up in the clouds.

3. The dead and living believers will be changed.

I Corinthians 15:51 “We will not all sleep, but we will all be changed – ^[52] In a flash, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed.”

4. We will be with the Lord forever.

I Thessalonians 4:17b “... And so, we will be with the Lord forever.”

I Thessalonians 4:18 “Therefore, encourage each other with these words.”

II. Jesus revealed the highway home.

A. Jesus is the way!

John 14:4 “You know the way to the place where I am going.”

John 14:5 “Thomas said to him, “Lord, we don’t know where you are going, so how can we know the way?”

John 14:6 “Jesus answered, “I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.”

Acts 4:12 “Salvation is found in no one else for there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved.”

John 3:15 “Everyone who believes in Him may have eternal life.”

John 3:16 “For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life.”

John 3:18 “Whoever believes in Him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because He has not believed in the name of God’s one and only Son.”

I Timothy 2:5 “For there is one God and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus. ^[6] who gave Himself a ransom for all men – the testimony given in its proper time.”

C. Jesus is the life!
