

I had the privilege this last Sunday of sitting on the main straightway across from the pit of the winner of the last two races, Josef Newgarden and was very disappointed when most likely a \$20 part broke on his car and he was out. He had only gone from last row position 32 to 9th when it broke. It seems that it's not the big things but the little that ruin an otherwise promising finish. I think we all can relate to that...

There were a few things that occurred that I would like to share. First, it was the first sell-out crowd in over a decade. Imagine 350,000 of your closest friends around a 2½ mile oval track all waiting for the green flag. But, before the race begins the track owner Roger Penske focused our attention on the real event of this Memorial Day which was to honor and remember those who have given their last full measure in the defense of our country. A moving tribute by the military honor guard, the singing of God Bless America and the National Anthem was moving but something happened that moved me more deeply. As hats were removed and covered hearts a bugler played Taps. 


