This song was composed in 1926 as a last-minute addition to the Rodgers and Hart musical Betsy and "Blue Skies" was an instant success. In 1927, it became one of the first songs to be featured in a talkie, when Al Jolson performed it in The Jazz Singer. The song was recorded by all the major labels of the time. A version was recorded by Benny Goodman and his Orchestra in 1935. Why Blue Skies? First, I hope that you are old enough to know the song and if not, you should listen to it on YouTube, it will brighten up your day, especially the Willie Nelson version. Second, last month I was beginning to wonder if we would ever see blue skies again but these last days have proven that we will and God is gracious to us. Just imagine driving your Model A in 1928 listening to the song on your dash AM radio (well...sorta).






