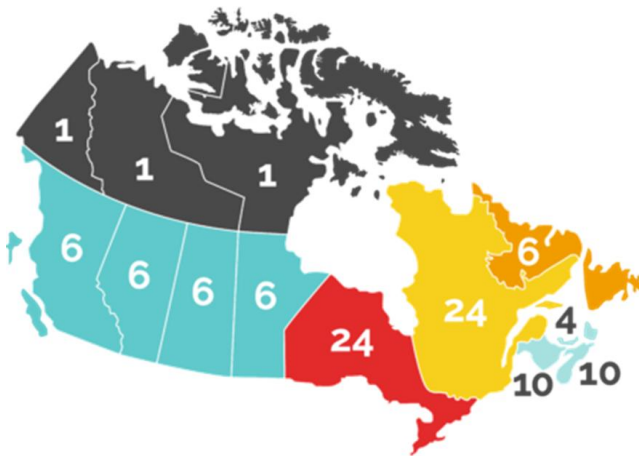

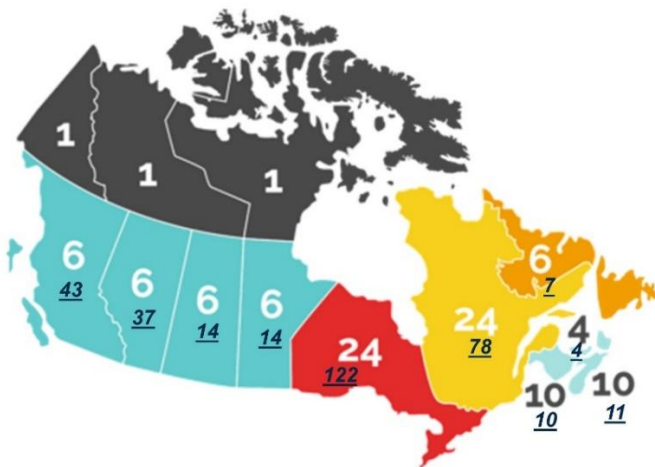

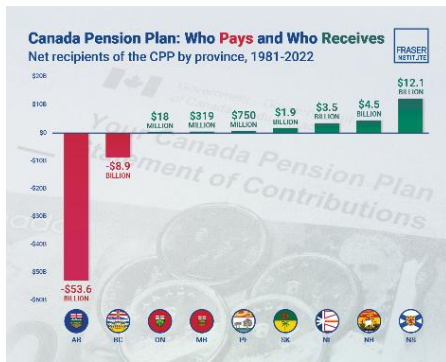
"The people of the North-West are allowed but a degree more control of their affairs than the serfs of Siberia."

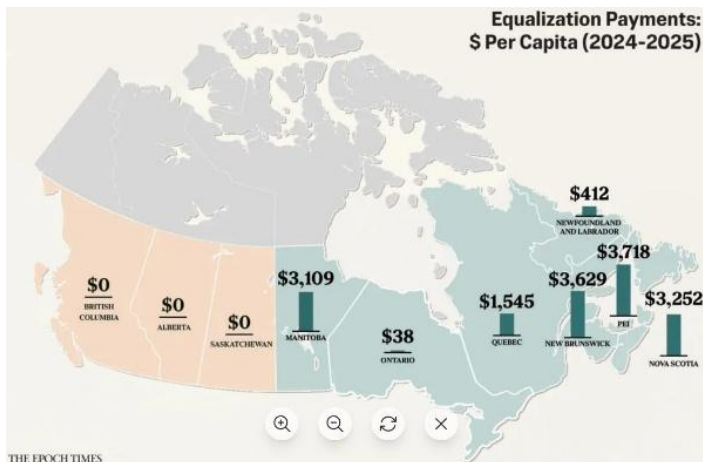

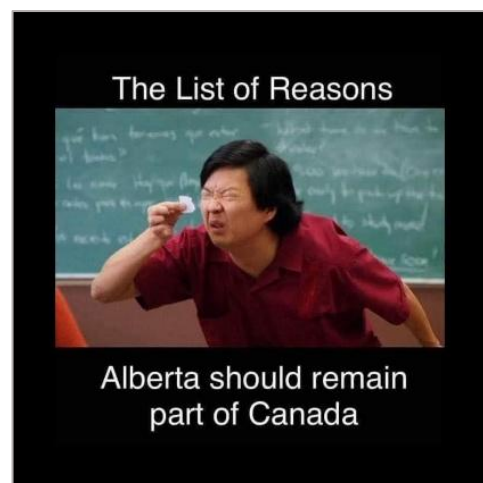
