Saco Community Garden Covid-19 Safety Practices

All Gardeners must read and follow these rules. Failure to follow these rules may lead to the City closing the garden.

- 1. DO NOT enter the garden if you have any COVID-19 symptoms or have had contact with a person infected with COVID-19, or feel sick. Follow Maine CDC guidelines about quarantines.
- 2. Wash your hands when you enter the garden and wash your hands when you leave the garden. Use the wash station or your own alcohol wipes or hand sanitizer.
- 3. Keep at least 6 feet distant from non-household members, unless you wear a mask.
- 4. If you can, bring your own tools.
- 5. The Volunteer Book has been removed from the shed. Report volunteer hours via email to sacocommunitygarden@gmail.com with your name, plot number, date, time spent and task description. Joel Hersom will tabulate volunteer hours completed.
- 6. These precautions should succeed if all gardeners practice them. The community garden should be a safe and healthy place for everyone during the COVID-19 pandemic. Ultimately, we are each responsible for our own safety. As time goes on, the SCG Steering Committee or the City may adjust these safety rules for improvements.
