

Parish Council Minutes 6-23-20

1. Meeting was called to order at 5:30 PM by Mickey. Fr. Louis led us in prayer.

6. Kris gave a festival update: The date is Aug 29. Raffle tickets will go on sale this weekend. The Home & School has kindly given the festival their larger prizes for our "Big 8" raffle. The proceeds of these prizes go to the Home & School Committee.
