

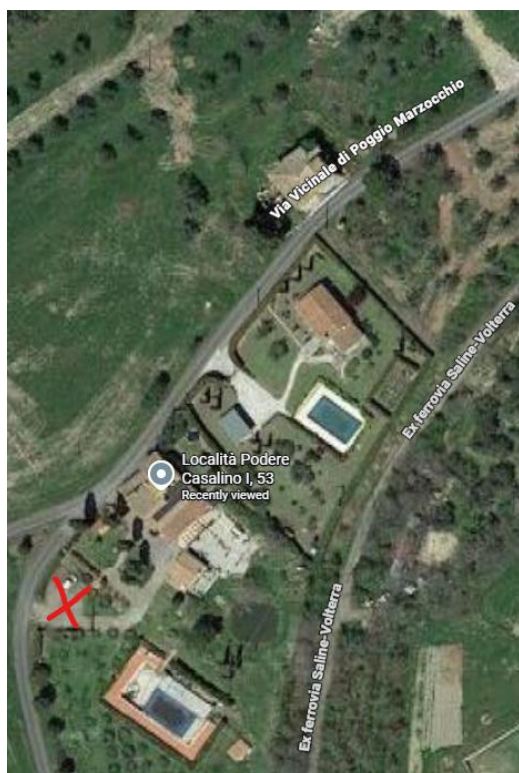
Key Information

- Podere Casalino Uno is located in Via Vicinale di Poggio Marzocchio snc, 56048 Volterra (Pisa), Tuscany, Italy
- It is about 2 km from the historic centre of Volterra

Driving from North – Pisa direction

- The drive from Pisa to Volterra is around 60 km and takes about 60 minutes depending on traffic & route

Driving from East – Florence/Siena direction

- The drive from Florence to Volterra is around 90 km and takes about 90 minutes depending on traffic & route. From Siena to Volterra is around 50 km and takes about 60 minutes depending on traffic & route.

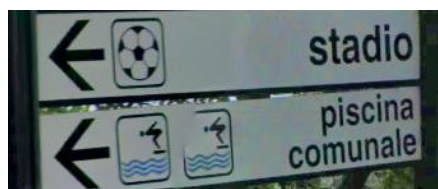
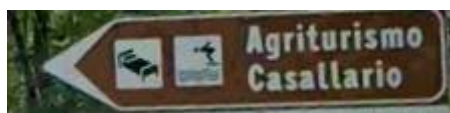
Driving from South/West – Cecina direction

- The drive from Cecina to Volterra is around 40 km and takes about 50 minutes depending on traffic & route

Suggested Local Driving Route

Located to the **South** of Volterra on the **SS 68** di Val Cecina Road

Take Exit onto Via dei Cappuccini following brown sign for “Agriturismo Casallario” and white signs for “football stadio” and “piscina comunale”.



Continue along Via dei Cappuccini for 300m passing the “stadio” (stadium) on your left



Continue down along Via dei Cappuccini through the narrow section for 300m



Continue down along Via dei Cappuccini with “piscina comunale” on your left and car park on your right.



Road now becomes Via Vicinale di Poggio Marzocchio (only 1.5Km to Podere Casalino)

Stay on Via Vicinale di Poggio Marzocchio by keeping/turning right following Podere Casalino road sign.



Continue downhill along Via Vicinale di Poggio Marzocchio and after 900m you can see Podere Casalino Uno from the road on your left.



Keep to the left following Podere Casalino road sign and the car park entrance is 10 metres around the corner



Tips & Considerations

- On the last kilometres, roads may be narrower and winding (hilly terrain) since you are getting into countryside. Go slowly especially if lanes are tight.
- Ensure GPS or map app is updated; cellular signal may drop intermittently in rural areas.
- Parking: we have private parking on-site
