Subject: Testimonial in Support of Global Mission Partners

Overflow Christian Community is a fellowship of believers who follow Jesus Christ, overflowing with His love to share His grace with all people. The church is committed to discipling children, students, and families for God's glory through the power of the Holy Spirit. This group feels a deep conviction to stand firmly on the truth of God's Word. They carried a spiritual burden to remain faithful to biblical teaching and the lordship of Christ.

The movement began through a time of deep prayer and intercession during a Prayer and Fasting Gathering held on December 26–30, 2022, at the Cainta Plant Nursery. This gathering became the spiritual foundation for the new fellowship, as participants sought God's direction and empowerment for the journey ahead. On January 14, 2023, the group officially adopted the name "Overflow Christian Community."

Without a permanent church building or dedicated gathering place, Overflow continued to seek spaces where the community could worship together—such as basketball courts, social halls, member's garage, and rented auditoriums. Each week, members faithfully hauled chairs, instruments, and equipment from one venue to another, embodying the heart of a church not built with walls, but on worship, prayer, and love for God's people – a borderless church.

In 2024, Pastor Ejay Lovidad, the Philippine Coordinator of Global Mission Partner (GMP), reached out to Overflow Christian Community to discuss a potential partnership focused on ministry support and mission expansion. In response, GMP Leaders and Overflow Pastors began holding online prayer meetings and weekly fasting that started in November 2024, seeking God's guidance for this new season of collaboration. During these online zoom meetings, the team carefully planned and prayed over specific activities, strategies, and execution steps, including the preparation of missionary partners who would join the upcoming mission trip scheduled for June 2025.

As GMP released funding to help renovate and upgrade the existing facilities of our Mission Church in Pililla which would culminate in a June 14 – 20 Mission Trip there. The plan also included a June 21-24 mission trip at Overflow-Cainta which was the main Overflow Christian Community Church.

The GMP Team arrived, bringing with them a spirit of passion and servant leadership. Throughout their stay, they actively and wholeheartedly participated in the various ministry activities that had been prayerfully prepared in advance. The team not only supported but also personally led and implemented programs alongside our local volunteers, strengthening fellowship, empowering local leaders, and reaching out to children, youth, and families in the community. Their partnership became a tangible expression of God's love in action, uniting both teams in one purpose: to glorify Christ and expand His kingdom through service and compassion.

Highlights of the said programs and activities in Overflow-Pililla:

The preparations: On June 14, GMP missionaries devoted the entire afternoon to unpacking boxes, sorting items, repacking supplies, and carefully organizing donations for distribution.



Sewing Ministry - They conducted sewing workshops for women, generously providing four complete sewing machine – including a step-down transformer and power strip, and so with essential materials for livelihood.



Childrens Ministry and Backpack Project – Some One Hundred and Twenty (120) backpacks were joyfully distributed to children and students, each thoughtfully filled with essential school supplies, writing materials, and a small toy surprise.



Welding Basics Workshop - They also conducted workshop on Basic Welding for men and provided high-end tig welding machines – including hand gloves, welding masks, and several consumables like grinding discs, cutting discs and welding rods.



Jewelry and Crafts Making for Youth and Kids – Bracelet and necklace making using stone pendants and wooden crosses was taught, sparking creativity and excitement among both children and youth participants.



Ministry with the Elderly - GMP also spent meaningful time with the elderly at One Cainta Sunset Retreat (Home for the Aged), sharing food, fellowship, prayers, songs, and words of encouragement.



Visit to Prayer Mountain – To conclude the mission trip, the team visited Touch of Glory Prayer Mountain, spending time in God's presence to offer thanksgiving, worship, and return all praise and glory to Him for the fruitful journey and ministry.
