## Code of Conduct Draft Policy 6/24/2025 Final Document Adopted 07/14/2025

Members of the Bronco Cheer Boosters (BCB) recognize that the purpose of the BCB is to promote good sportsmanship, squad unity and mutual respect among the membership, cheerleaders, coaches, school administration, other school organizations and the community by elevating, advocating, promoting and financially supporting the Lake Belton High School, North Belton Middle School and Lake Belton Middle School Bronco Cheerleading programs. Therefore, we agree as follows:

- 1. Members recognize that the Code of Conduct, Bylaws, Standing Rules and all documents listed within each are the guidelines for the BCBC.
- 2. Members will adhere to the Code of Conduct, Bylaws and Standing Rules, and will resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
- 3. Members will not encourage any behaviors or practices that would endanger the health and well being of any athlete, coach, administrator or member.
- 4. Members will follow BISD rules forbidding tobacco, alcohol and drug use at all BISD sporting events.
- 5. Members will never verbally condemn any participants for mistakes or faults during practices, games, events or meetings.
- 6. Members and their guests will be positive role models to all children and will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, parent, athlete, or

- member (such as booing, taunting, refusing to shake hands, or using profane language or gestures). Members will respect officials and their authority during games.
- 7. Members will always speak POSITIVE words about the team, athletes, coaches, parents, members and the BCB.
- 8. Members will refrain from texting or posting any negative or derogatory remarks regarding any official, coach, athlete, parent, member, teacher, coach, or the booster club using any text or social media/internet forum.
- Members agree that failure to abide by the aforementioned rules and guidelines may lead to removal from the club and/or other actions deemed appropriate by the BCB Board.
