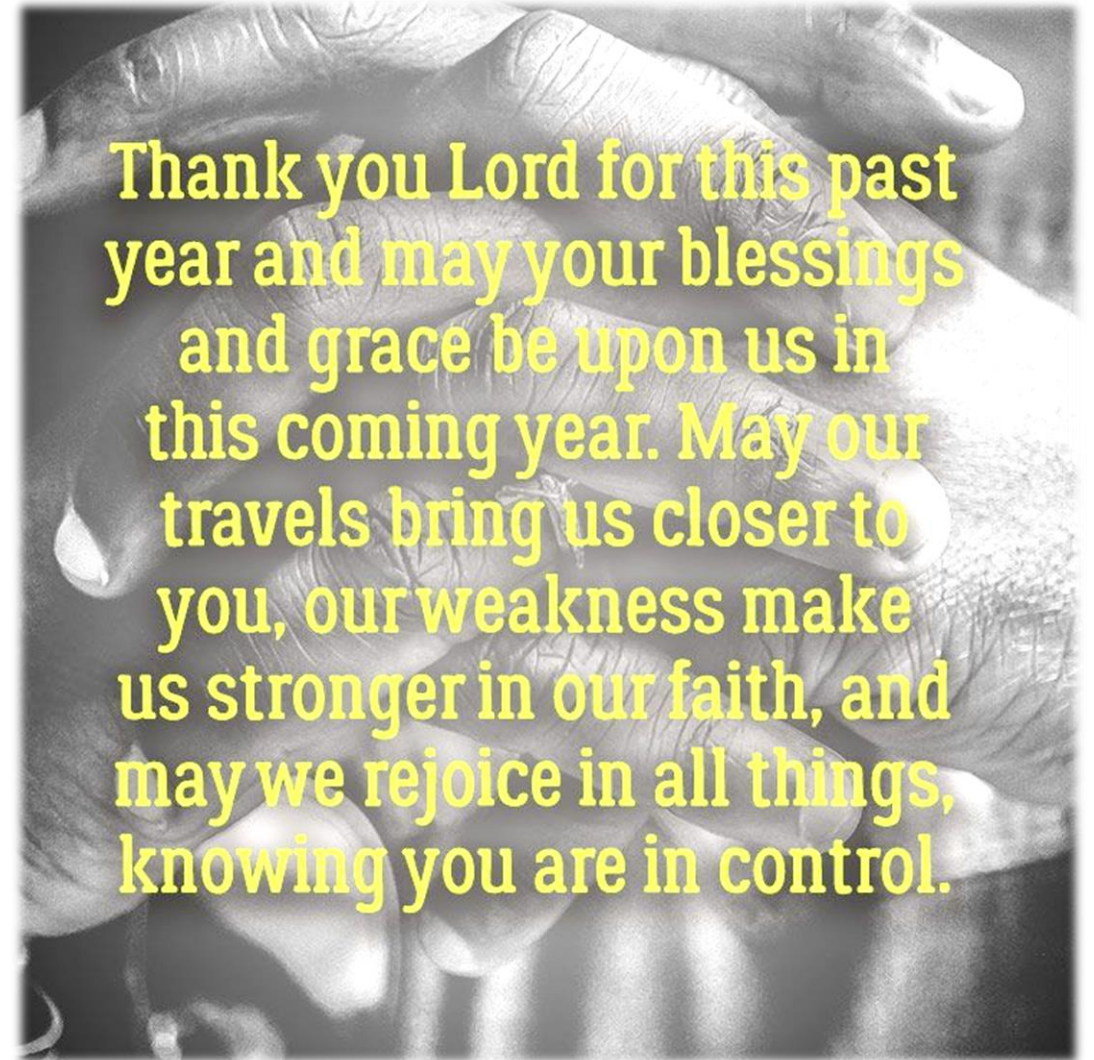
Childcare: Will be provided in the nursery by Margie Johnson - ages 3 to 2nd grade.
