

LIFE GROUP QUESTIONS

1. Read Luke 24-1-10. What insight, lesson, or observation from this weekend's message did you find to be the most helpful, eye-opening, or troubling? How was your experience with the Life Tool's this past week?

2. How do you think our culture typically views Easter? How have you viewed it?

3. Read Romans 5:9-11 and 6:23. What does this passage say about why Easter had to happen?

4. Read 1 Corinthians 15:12-19. Why is the resurrection being true so important?

5. Read Romans 8:1-4 and 2 Corinthians 5:18-21. What does the fact that Jesus Christ rose from the grave tell us?

6. Read Acts 1:8 and 2 Corinthians 5:17. What does the resurrection mean for your life today?

7. Read 1 Corinthians 15:20-23 and Revelation 21:1-4. What does the resurrection mean for your life in the future?

LIFE TOOLS

Singles: How has the resurrection of Jesus changed your life? Set aside some time this week and thank the Lord for your salvation and for the power of the resurrection that is at work in you right now.

Couples: The resurrection changed everything! Your life is now attached to Jesus in his death, burial, and resurrection. Your spouse may already no your testimony but go ahead and share it with each other again. Our testimony often focuses on how we received forgiveness in Jesus, but this time add another layer and share how the resurrection of Jesus is working in your life now.

Parents of Preschoolers – 6th: Pick-up the Glow in the Dark Easter Egg Hunt Kit at the Family Easter Event tables outside the Worship building. The kit comes with a devotional that you can do as a family and tie's the egg hunt to talk about how Jesus is the light of the world.

Parents of Teenagers Verse 6 of Matthew 28 says, "He is not here; he has risen, just as he said. Come and see the place where he lay." In the midst of the challenges of teen culture, school life/home life, and all the unreliability of today's world, encourage your teen that Jesus is who He says he is. He rose from the dead just as he said. Jesus is, The Spirit is, GOD is truly faithful and reliable. Further study - read w/your teen John 20:24-29, Heb 1:1-9.
