## Bible-Saturated Talk with Your Kids

These questions are intended to help you have more fruitful conversations with your kids, focused on who God is, what they believe, and what he is doing in their lives.

Using good questions like this is a great way to move from one-word answers to regular, deep, biblical conversations.

Use these questions regularly, and I promise you'll start having more fruitful conversations with kids of any age.

18. How would you describe Jesus to someone who has never heard of him?
19. Do you know anyone who believes in a different religion? What do they believe?
20. Do you think miracles can still happen?
21. Have you ever felt embarrassed about being a Christian?
22. What makes you feel close to God?
23. Why does God make some people boys and some people girls?
