



Wychdene Care Home




Wychdene Residential Home is a long-term residential care home for the placement of older people aged 65 onwards.

We specialise in providing support to males and females who can no longer live on their own and require help with washing, dressing, mobility and all aspects of personal care. Full nursing care is not provided provision is made for the treatment of disease, disorder or injury.



Residents are cared for 24 hours a day by dedicated and friendly staff. The proprietors and managers aim to provide a high standard of care and support without encroaching on the individual's right to privacy or choice. We aim to support resident's while maintaining as much independence as possible.

The management team and all staff from carers to kitchen to domestics take great pride in having gained an excellent reputation and constantly strive to maintain our high standards and quality care.



All residents have individual person centred care plans. Visitors are welcomed at any time and light refreshments are provided.

Wychedene is designed over three floors; all the corridors are wide and we have an five person lift enabling us to provide accommodation to residents with wheelchairs or walking aids.

There is a separate dining room, living room and library. The onsite cook provides good nutritional home cooking and caters to all diets and preferences.

Facilities in the home

Qualified care staff, 24 hour quality care, regular GP visits, 23 single rooms, all tastefully furnished. Television and wash basins in all rooms, 13 of which are En-suite rooms.

Two lounges, spacious dining room offering a varied and balanced menus; gardens with summer house. All laundry done on site daily and all areas have wheel chair access. The laundry room uses the best equipment to achieve disinfection and Infection control during the wash process. Interactive sensory table within the communal areas.
