Greenline bathroom & shower cleaner will also restore freshness to all your surfaces in the bathroom and maintain a safety barrier to any bacteria, germs, mould or mildew.

Also available with more power, Greenline Bathroom surface cleaner EXTRA STRENGTH, handles cleaning any bathroom that experiences heavy and vigorous traffic.



SIZES AVAILABLE

Greenline bathroom & shower cleaner is available in a 500ml trigger spray bottle. Same applies for Greenline bathroom cleaner Extra Strength

The product is available in a 1 litre container that provides 2 x 500ml refill for the 500ml trigger spray bottle.

CLEANING METHODS

Greenline bathroom and shower cleaner can be used in every corner of the bathroom.

Overtime the clear glass on **shower screens** will be stained with a white residue of soap scum and water stains. By cleaning the shower screen once a week with Greenline bathroom & shower cleaner, the clarity of the clean clear glass will be maintained. Tea staining, soap scum and limescale will also be removed and the surface of the **shower rose, taps, hand showers** and **shower drains** will be brightened and prevent damage to your fixtures.

Mould and mildew from the **tiles** can be removed by simply spraying the Greenline bathroom and shower cleaner over the affected area and agitate it into the surface. Let the product rest on the surface for 1-5 minutes. Wash off. Repeat if necessary. The blackness of the mould may not disappear initially because it is embedded into the surface that it has grown on. The mould will not grow or recolonise, and the black discolour should disappear.

And of course, **toilets** inside and out, **vanity basins, bathtubs** and surrounds will shine white and reflective when clean with Greenline bathroom & shower cleaner. A handy product to use daily, as required.

CAUTION

All Greenline cleaning products are completely safe however a caution has been placed on the label to ensure that you are aware of potential reactions to surfaces and certain types of materials.

To avoid any reaction with the surface, always test the product in an inconspicuous location before using it on the main surface.

Be aware of cleaning unprotected natural stone or concrete and composite metals such as chrome and brass plated metals. These materials are soft and sensitive and may react to the light acidity of Greenline bathroom & shower cleaner. The natural stone or concrete surface may appear etched on the location it was used. The coating of chrome or brass may be removed.

SURFACES

Besides the grime that is brought into the bathroom, the main dirty evidence found is soap residue build-up, water stains and mould or mildew from the hot water steam and lack of ventilation. Greenline Bathroom & shower cleaner clears all the evidence to leave a fresh and safe environment in the bathroom.

The rear label of all Greenline Cleaning products outline recommended surfaces for the product. This is covered in the cleaning methods section.

Important information regarding grime in a bathroom

Grime is in various forms as outlined below;

- a white film on the glass shower screen, drains, soap dish and shampoo and conditioner containers.
- the dullness of stainless-steel shower heads, spouts and taps
- coloured water streaks in the toilet
- scale forming in the base of the bath or on the shower floor tiles.
- mould and mildew in the shower or bath If water is present on a surface for a length of time it provides a medium for mould and mildew to grow.
- Black spots occur in grout, on tiles and the ceiling.

DIRECTIONS

All Greenline cleaning products are strong and clean very efficiently and effectively. Generally a light spray across the surface is all that is required. And perhaps an extra spray on a heavy spot if required.

The rear label of all Greenline Cleaning products outline specific cleaning directions for the product to obtain the best cleaning results.

Greenline bathroom & shower cleaner keeps on working to clean the longer it is left on the surface. Leaving it on the surface between 1-5 minutes in troubled dirty areas of scale, mould and mildew, will allow the solution to breakdown and remove the old face revealing a fresh-looking surface. A simple wipe-away with a clean wet absorbent cloth to achieve the cleanest result.

For general surfaces such as vanity benchtops, cupboard doors toilet seats, lids and bathtubs, Greenline bathroom & shower cleaner will sanitise and kill 99.999% of bacteria and germs when left on the surface for only 30 seconds. To complete the process, wipe off with a clean wet absorbent cloth.

BEYOND THE KITCHEN INTO THE BATHROOM

Not only does Greenline kitchen degreaser manages cleaning grease and grime in the kitchen, it can also do the same in the bathroom.

In the same manner, Greenline kitchen degreaser removes the oils from a rejuvenating bath, or organic matter from the floors or inside the toilet.

Use the **Light dilution** in the spray trigger bottles to apply to clean general build-up on surfaces and the heavy Remember the **heavy solution (not diluted)** will clean and sanitise when left to stand on the surface for 1 minute before rinsing of with a wet absorbent cloth.
