

INTRODUCTION

Surfaces that are in frequent use can carry bacteria and germs that can be transmitted from one surface to the next with human movement around the home. Greenline surface sanitiser will create a protective barrier to stop bacteria and germs at the front door.Killing 99.999% of bacteria and germs without the use of traditional toxic ingredients, such as chlorine or bleach or quaternary ammonium.

Best used on frequently ultised surfaces like tabletops, chair backrests and armrests, coffee tables, door handles, railings, fridge handles, kitchen sink, laundry tub, study desks, light switches.

Just like sanitising your hands, this product will make your home environment safe for all the family as well as your visitors.









SIZES AVAILABLE

Greenline surface sanitiser is available in a 500ml trigger spray bottle.

The product is available in a 1 litre container that provides 2 x 500ml refill for the 500ml trigger spray bottle.







CLEANING METHODS

The intention of Greenline surface sanitiser is not to apply it to the surface as a cleaner but to compliment cleaning the home from everyday mess. Our surface sanitiser will kill bacteria and germs that grow or settle on surfaces around the home.

To use around the home in the bedroom, bathroom, kitchen and general living areas simply spray and leave for 30 seconds to any surface and the sanitising effect will occur.

Examples of use include before and after visitors or when the kids come home from school and even after you bring the groceries home from the shops..

To avoid any reaction with the surface, always test the product in an inconspicuous location before using it on the main surface

Note: Be aware of cleaning unprotected natural stone or concreate and composite metals such as chrome and brass plated metals. These materials soft and sensitive and may react to the light acidity of Greenline surface sanitiser. The natural stone or concrete surface may appear etched on the location it was used. The coating of chrome or brass may be removed.

A home contains many different types of surfaces within each room. Greenline surface sanitiser is a light active solution and is suitable for all protected hard surfaces, like plastic, vinyl, timber laminates, and veneers, glass, ceramic and metals.

The rear label of all Greenline Cleaning products outline recommended surfaces for the product. Each surface type requires a different cleaning method to obtain the expected result of cleaning. This is covered in the cleaning methods section.

Important information regarding stainless steel.

Stainless steel is a material that is difficult to clean and shine without ghosting or swipe marks being left behind. The marks left behind are just residue caught on the surface and need to be wiped off. Often a dry towel is enough, but sometimes the surface has grooves and requires another rinse.

Stainless steel is a strong and durable metal that is widely used to make and cover items. It has various grades of metal quality that match the varying degrees of resistance to corrosion. It is a pliable metal and can be easily cut, shaped and seamlessly welded together. The surface can be finished with grooves or flat without. In the kitchen, stainless steel is a common stylish finish found on joinery, fridges, ovens, cook tops, range hoods and machine parts.
