New or worn-in surfaces are rejuvenated and sanitised when cleaned with Greenline kitchen degreaser and it will deep clean and leave the surface touch-test free of all greases, fatty oils, burnt-on messes and stubborn splatters, for cooker hoods, grills, ovens, microwaves, burner grates, cupboards, benches, floors, walls and barbeques.

SIZES AVAILABLE

Greenline kitchen degreaser is available in 1 litre container.

As the product is a dilutable solution for different applications, empty labelled spray bottles with adjustable heads are also available and recommended to be used for easy product identity when stored and in-use.







CLEANING METHODS

The **light dilution** when placed in the spray trigger bottle is always on hand when left by the kitchen sink. It can be used at anytime during the cooking process. Great for cutting boards, pots, pans, woks, casserole dishes and crockery baking dishes after use. Simply, spray, agitate and rinse clean with water.

The **heavy solution (not diluted)** also placed in the spray trigger bottle can be used to assist with the more stubborn baked on messes after baking or roasting, or wherever the cooking process splatters and charred food. Whether it is cooked in the oven, on the stovetop or absorbed by the rangehood these messes will be removed with an easy spray, agitate and a rinse clean after use.

Another great way to use Greenline Kitchen degreaser is as a **soak**. For example Rangehood exhausts, kitchen equipment parts from the oven or even pots and pans are best cleaned by soaking. Refer to the dilution table to create the right concentration to soak, Add the required solution into a bucket or sink of water, place the item in the bucket or sink and let stand. Agitate as well. The items can be left soaking over night and then rinse clean with water in the morning.

And of course don't forget you can always **mop** the floor in the kitchen by simply referring to the dilution table to create the right concentration. Refer to the "**beyond the kitchen into the general living**" section for more information

All Greenline cleaning products are completely safe however a caution has been placed on the label to ensure that you are aware of potential reactions to surfaces and certain types of materials.

To avoid any reaction with the surface, always test the product in an inconspicuous location before using it on the main surface.

Be aware of cleaning with Aluminium and Zinc. Both metals are soft and sensitive materials and may react to the alkalinity of Greenline kitchen degreaser. The appearance of the metal surface may change unless it is protected by another coating that has the appropriate resistance.

As an alkaline concentrate, we have categorised the product with a low-risk warning which may cause skin and eve irritation. If irritation does occur, wash the affected area under water for several minutes.

DILUTION TABLE

Versatility and reliability are two features Greenline kitchen degreaser has to offer when covering all your cleaning requirements in the kitchen.

Greenline kitchen degreaser is a dilutable heavy duty solution that can be made into various concentrations for 5 different actions, Light, Heavy, Sanitise, Soak, and Mop.

The **light** dilution and **heavy** can be placed in a spray trigger bottle, to easily spray when using to clean or sanities or placed in a bucket to mop or soak.

On the rear label, refer to the dilution table to create the right concentration for the surface you wish to cleaned.

SURFACES

A kitchen contains the more surface finishes than any other room in the house and Greenline kitchen cleaner is versatile clean and sanitise many of these surfaces.

The rear label of all Greenline Cleaning products outline recommended surfaces for the product. Each surface type requires a different cleaning method to obtain the expected result of cleaning. This is covered in the cleaning methods section.

Important information regarding stainless steel.

Stainless steel is a material that is difficult to clean and shine without ghosting or swipe marks being left behind. The marks left behind are just residue caught on the surface and need to be wiped off. Often a dry towel is enough, but sometimes the surface has grooves and requires another rinse.

Stainless steel is a strong and durable metal that is widely used to make and cover items. It has various grades of metal quality that match the varying degrees of resistance to corrosion. It is a pliable metal and can be easily cut, shaped and seamlessly welded together. The surface can be finished with grooves or flat without. In the kitchen, stainless steel is a common stylish finish found on joinery, fridges, ovens, cook tops, range hoods and machine parts.

DIRECTIONS

All Greenline cleaning products are strong and clean very efficiently and effectively. Generally a light spray across the surface is all that is required. And perhaps an extra spray on a heavy spot if required.


The rear label of all Greenline Cleaning products outline specific cleaning directions for the product to obtain the best cleaning results.

You have two ways to use the Greenline kitchen degreaser, to dissolve grease and grime or to sanitise surfaces that do not make direct contact with food.

The Greenline kitchen degreaser loves to sit and work. Leaving it on the surface between 1-5 minutes will allow the grease and grime to dissolve and then all that is required is a simple wipe-away with a clean wet absorbent cloth to achieve the cleanest result.

For general surfaces that do not make direct contact with food, such as benchtops, cupboard doors and floors, Greenline kitchen degreaser will sanitise and kill 99.99% of bacteria and germs when left on the surface for only 1 minute. To complete the process, wipe off with a clean wet absorbent cloth.





TO CLEAN: Lightly spray and agitate across the whole surface with a light to medium grade scourer sponge. Let stand for 1-5 minutes for a deep clean. Wipe off with a clean wet absorbent cloth. Wine dry. Repeat if needed.

TO SANITISE (non food contact surfaces only): Lightly spray across the surface and let stand for 1 minute. Wipe off with a clean wet absorbent cloth. Repeat if needed.

BEYOND THE KITCHEN INTO THE GENERAL LIVING AREA

There is more to the Greenline kitchen degreaser, than just in the name. It is a hard surface floor cleaner for all areas.

Greenline kitchen degreaser can be used for all hard surface floors, such as tiles, vinyl, floating timber floorboards, solid timber and concrete.

Create a **Mop dilution** in a bucket and mop away all grease and grime off the floor. The dilution can be varied to suit the depth of cleaning required. Try a lighter dilution first.

Once applied to the whole floor, follow through wiping it clean with a bucket of fresh water. It is good practise as you clean the floor to change the bucket of water with fresh water to prevent reapplying the dirty water back onto the floor. For a streak free finish, dry off with a towel or let the floor air dry.
