My dear parishioners,

This Corpus Christi Sunday (June 22<sup>nd</sup>), we have planned to have a small outdoor *Corpus Christi* procession around the Church immediately after the 11 AM Mass. This centuries old tradition, so strongly encouraged by the Church, is an opportunity for us to give a more prominent place to the Eucharist and to

celebrate Christ's real presence in the Sacred Host. "The Corpus Christi procession represents the typical form of a Eucharistic procession. It is a prolongation of the celebration of the Eucharist: immediately after Mass, the Sacred Host, consecrated during the Mass, is borne out of the Church for the Christian faithful 'to make public profession of faith and worship of the Most Blessed Sacrament'. The faithful understand and appreciate the values inherent in the procession: they are aware of being 'the People of God', journeying with the Lord, and proclaiming faith in him who has become truly 'God-amongst-us'" (Directory of Popular Piety paragraph 162, promulgated 2001). The Eucharist is Jesus Himself, no mere symbol or reminder. And so we worship, adore, and receive with love this Jesus who has said to us, "this is my body." "I am the bread of life."

The Euthanasia Prevention Coalition (EPC) is in need of funds to support their efforts to uphold the dignity of every human life. Alex Schadenberg, who does great work with the EPC, is helping save lives and oppose efforts by many to make euthanasia a more regular occurrence in society. As disciples of Jesus who follow a Biblical worldview, we believe that each and every human life is sacred, and we wish to protect vulnerable persons from the pressure to end their own lives. Therefore, I am personally pledging to match at least \$1000 to help support this organization and the great works they do. If you'd like to help with this cause, please let us know in the office.

Our parish has applied for and received a summer job grant from the Canadian government, and so this summer we expect to have a young lady named *Rain* helping us here at the parish with various tasks. We will be grateful for her presence and assistance – please make her feel very welcome when you see her!

He has served here since his ordination on August 14<sup>th</sup>, 2020.
