My dear parishioners,

I pray this week you are feeling even more filled than ever with the Holy Spirit's power, since we've just celebrated Pentecost! May we always ask that the Holy Spirit continue to pour out abundantly on our parish!

This weekend we celebrate Trinity Sunday. It gives us chance to reflect on what it means that believe that God is Three Divine Persons, in One Divine Substance. The Father, Son and Holy Spirit are distinct Persons but they all share the one Godhead together. The Father eternally begets the Son, and the Love between the Father and the Son is so real that it becomes a Third Person, the Holy Spirit. In Baptism, we too begin sharing in the life of Christ, meaning that we are 'in Christ', and therefore immersed into the loving and lifegiving action of the Trinity who made us in their own image and likeness, desiring that we too would love and be loved as they are. Everyone needs to love and feel loved. It is our goal as disciples to make this happen. Every family is meant to be an image of the Trinity, too. For example, the love of the parents is often so real that it becomes a third person, and God-willing, many more beautiful children also born, who are in turn called to experience the Trinity and share Their love. Since the Trinity is a Communion of Persons sharing in divine love, and we are made in their image and likeness, we too are called to live in communion with God and neighbour, sharing with one another the love that the Trinity gives us.

This weekend we celebrate Father's Day, a chance to be grateful to the Trinity for our earthly fathers, through whom we came to receive the gift of life. We should show extra love and gratitude to our Heavenly Father, to St. Joseph our spiritual father, and to our earthly fathers in whatever ways we can. Please try doing at least one special thing for each of them for this occasion! The Catholic Women's League (CWL) will also offer fathers "Dad's cookies" as a sweet sign of our love and affection for all that fathers do. Fathers are called by God to lead their families closer and closer to the Heavenly Father, so that they may experience the fullness of human flourishing under the guidance of the Trinity.

I've recently been made aware that Deacon Joe, our parish's permanent Deacon, is being assigned to a nearby parish, Our Lady of the Assumption. He has served here since his ordination on August 14th, 2020. We are grateful for every positive contribution that Deacon Joe has given to our parish since his ordination and assignment here. Of course, he is always welcome here. I ask you to please keep him and his family in your prayers as he makes this transition.

On Corpus Christi (June 22nd), we will have a small outdoor *Corpus Christi procession* around the Church immediately after the 11 AM Mass. This centuries old tradition, so strongly encouraged by the Church, is an opportunity for us to give a more prominent place to the Eucharist and to celebrate Christ's real presence in the Sacred Host. "The *Corpus Christi* procession represents the typical form of a Eucharistic procession. It is a prolongation of the celebration of the Eucharist: immediately after Mass, the Sacred Host, consecrated during the Mass, is borne out of the Church for the Christian faithful 'to make public profession of faith and worship of the Most Blessed Sacrament'. The faithful understand and appreciate the values inherent in the procession: they are aware of being 'the People of God', journeying with the Lord, and proclaiming faith in him who has become truly 'God-amongst-us'" (*Directory of Popular Piety paragraph 162, promulgated 2001*).

I also want to note that this upcoming week we'll be celebrating St. Gabriel's graduation on June 17th, which will take place at 5 PM. May the Trinity and our Blessed Mother watch over them, so that as the years go by, our young people become salt and light for the world according to Christ's teachings! May Jesus keep our young people and our schools in His Sacred Heart. If you're coming for confessions and/or Mass that Tuesday evening, you may notice more cars parked than usual! Thank you for being such a warm and welcoming parish.

May our Eucharistic Lord abundantly bless all of you with the graces of His Sacred Heart, $\,$
