I think it's always fascinating to understand how our forefathers in the faith celebrated Mass for centuries, aware that the Church sees the legitimate liturgical reforms of Vatican II as in harmony with what came before it. If you're interested in this kind of topic, you might read Sacrosanctum Concilium, Vatican II's document on the Sacred Liturgy. I personally like Vatican II, and wish that more people would read these beautiful texts which contain so much wisdom from the Holy Spirit!

I previously shared how I really enjoyed watching the film Permission by Kevin Dunn about Fr. Bob Bedard - and I now have very good news! On September 24th at 7 PM, we will have a screening of the film where Kevin Dunn himself and other priests will join us. Please join us for this film, it is powerful and will help you to welcome God even more deeply into your life!
