Dear parishioners,

As I write this, I am on a coach bus from Rome to Assisi. We have spent the last four days in Rome, during which we've walked through all the Holy Doors at St. Mary Major, St. John Lateran, St. Paul's Outside the Walls, and St. Peter's Basilica. I've had the privilege of saying Mass in many beautiful places, and of exploring Rome. If you follow me on Instagram or Facebook, and if you follow our parish's social media, then

you are aware of some of the highlights of the trip already. You can find some really neat photos and videos there! I've also had the chance to attend an audience with Pope Leo XIV, getting about 15 feet away from him thanks to a priest friend of mine with some special connections! I also had a chance to reconnect with other priest friends at the Pontifical Canadian College in Rome, and I've also made some new friends!

Some of the things that stands out to me (I could honestly write a small book already about the experiences) have been witnessing the universality and unity of the Church (there are people here from all over the world who can worship together easily and peacefully), and how various aspects of our faith can hit in an even deeper way when you are there. For example, saints I have learned about and prayed to for years, I have now visited their places of rest for the first time. I have also had the chance to see the resting places of Pope Francis and St. John Paul II. Being in the Sistine chapel and seeing the Vatican Museums – all of these experiences and many more have helped me to get more in touch with the beautiful roots of our faith. There is nothing quite like praying at the resting places of St. Peter and St. Paul, or seeing the great masterpieces of Michelangelo in person.

Sharing this jubilee year pilgrimage with others from the parish has also been a great blessing. We keep you in our prayers, please keep us in yours!

I am grateful for the priests who are covering at the parish while I'm away, and for the support you give them.

May God continue to bless us in this jubilee year!

May is the month of Mary, we have a statue of Mary and her Immaculate Heart to help remind us to stay close to her. May she intercede for us and help our hearts to follow the Sacred Heart of her Divine Son.

"The Chosen" season 3 continues Saturday nights – if you've never watched it, I encourage you to try watching the series which I think you'll find extremely moving and very thought-provoking! While the writers take some creative license, still the series offers profound insights into the life and ministry of Jesus Christ. It helps many to reflect on the Gospels and apply it to their lives.

Seminarian Giuseppe Njualem continues to enjoy is time here at the parish, and will be with us for most of the summer. Please continue to pray for him, support him, and greet him when you see him!
