"Where the faithful should be in the painful impossibility of receiving sacramental absolution, it should be remembered 1)that I repent of such things; that perfect contrition, coming from the love of God, loved 2) In his name I renounce such things and; above all else, expressed by a sincere request of forgiveness 3) In his name I claim freedom from such things. (one which the penitent is able to express in that moment) and accompanied by the votum confessionis, that is by the firm Then I ask him to fill me with his Holy Spirit again. This is the resolution to receive sacramental confession as soon as possible, obtains the forgiveness of sins, even mortal ones (cf.ccc.N. 1452)"

I exhort and encourage everyone to make use of this opportunity this Easter season and turn to God for forgiveness, even of grievous sins. In particular, for those who have sinned against the 1st Commandment (the most important one), this Easter can be the great opportunity for deliverance from bondage This might pertain, for instance to those who have been engaging with psychics, with Tarot cards, ouija boards, fortune tellers, witchcraft "games", etc.
