**DEAR FELLOW PARISHIONERS;** The Advent season, which begins another liturgical year, is almost with us. As it is proclaimed during the Sundays of Advent, God's Word has a special quality;

notes of hope, of patient anticipation, of light in the darkness and joy in the silence echo through the Sunday readings. Over and over, the Spirit of God whispers in our hearts "God is coming", "Jesus is coming", "Come Lord Jesus!"

Looking to Sts Augustine and Monica, Louis and Elizabeth, Maximillian Kolbe; Joseph and Mary and John the Baptist, we will reflect on how God's message of hope speaks from palaces and prisons, sinners and saints. Come Lord Jesus!
