

DEAR FELLOW PARISHIONERS; We are all grateful to God and to our church for giving us the season of Lent, a season of grace par excellence. During Lent we relive the spiritual

dimension of the 40 years that the Chosen People spent in the wilderness, a time that prepared them to enter the Promised Land. We join in spirit our Lord Jesus and his 40 days in the desert, a time of inner preparation for the inauguration of the Kingdom of God. This Lent we invite you to participate in a wide assortment of opportunities for prayer and spiritual preparation.



1) A Lecture series on the Holy Mass: Organized by seminarian Peter Robinson, this series features five Sunday meetings at the church, beginning at 10a.m. and leading to the 11a.m. Sunday Mass.

2) The Parish Mission: Based on the theme: "What is the Spirit saying to the Churches?" our mission will be held from Sunday, March 31 until Wednesday, April 3. All services begin at 7p.m. A special feature of the mission will be our ensemble of speakers. We will hear from Deacon Vivek Trindade (Sunday), Deacon Greg Merkley (Monday), Seminarian Peter Robinson (Tuesday); and Deacon-in-formation Joe Gigliotti (Wednesday). Confessions will be available on each night of the mission from 6-7p.m. and from 8-9p.m.

- All-Day Confessions: Wednesday, April 17 (Wednesday of Holy Week). From 10a.m. to 9p.m. there will be at least one priest, (sometimes two or even three) available to hear confessions.
- 4) Stations of the Cross/Evening Prayer: Starting at 7p.m. on the Friday evenings of Lent.
- 5) **Lenten Sunday Homily Series:** based on the theme "the Spirit of Lent" Father Bill will preach on the essential role of the Holy Spirit as seen through the unique perspective of Luke's Gospel.

Join us for one or all of the Lenten activities.


