The Farm will also provide a place where volunteers and the poor and marginalized can work and give back to the community in a meaningful way. There is a Peace Garden at The Farm where people can be outside and pray in silence and peace surrounded by nature. The Farm is a natural extension to the mission of DeMazenod Door Outreach.

At our parish, who are great supporters of DeMazenod Door and feeding those who come to The Door, we are hoping to reopen our parish kitchen in September (assuming the government health guidelines are lifted) to once again provide delicious home cooked meals for The Door. In the meantime, we are grateful to Genuine Bakery for stepping in and providing the meals on our behalf. This is only possible through the generosity of our parishioners for which we are extremely thankful and wish many of God's Blessings upon each one of you.

Listening requires our full attention, not just to the words spoken, but also to the emotions attached.
