Dear Parish family,

I was recently asked about the use of Latin at the Mass. The only time we currently use Latin at Sunday Masses is for the Lamb of God, or Agnus Dei. In English, take away the sins of the world, have mercy on us." After that is repeated again, in English we say, "Lamb of God, you take away the sins of the world, grant us

peace." The Latin version of that is Agnus Dei, qui tollis peccata mundi, In Jesus' time, people used one language for regular conversation miserere nobis ... and the third time ending with dona nobis pacem.
