

DIOCESAN CAPITAL CAMPAIGN: PROGRESS REPORT DEAR FELLOW PARISHIONERS, One of

the highlights of the past year was our parish involvement in the Diocesan Capital Campaign. Year's end being a time for reflection on significant events, I though it appropriate to give a brief report on the progress of the campaign in our parish.

By year's end we have raised approximately \$330,000.00 in donations and pledges. Actual money received (from pledges in process of being fulfilled) is around \$100,000.00. As well the diocese has promised us \$60,000.00 from the campaign in order to help our special situation (having to pay off the mortgage on our 10 yr old church and facilities).

Very soon we will be able to access our funds in order to address the campaign projects. One of the projects was to hire a part-time caretaker and to attend to such maintenance needs as a second furnace. Our finance committee has advised me that this should be a priority, especially in the aftermath of an expensive problem with our alarm system that occurred recently.

A second project envisaged by our campaign was to obtain more help with youth ministry in the parish and in the area. The advice of the finance committee is that we hold this project in abeyance until more money has been raised.

I've been greatly impressed with the generous response from you, dear parishioners, to the Bishop's appeal. As I've already stated to many of you; I'd like to state to all: "May our good Lord, who will not be outdone in generosity, bless you and your loved ones abundantly and super abundantly in the year ahead and beyond."

This year we made \$1,000 Christmas donations to the Cancer Assistance Program in Hamilton, Hamilton Right to Life, Martha House, De Mazenod Door Outreach, and Christian Refugees Fund.
