July 28<sup>th</sup> is *World Day of Prayer for Grandparents and the Elderly.* On Sunday, July 28, 2024, we will celebrate the 4th World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly, which was initiated by Pope Francis. This year's theme, "Do not cast me off in my old age" (Ps 71:9), reminds us of the loneliness many elderly people face. We are called to value and honor grandparents and the elderly in our community. We invite you to put effort into continuing to honor, love, and serve our beloved elderly, and

to reach out to those who may feel isolated or alone. Your phone calls, visits and presence can make a world of difference, showing them that they are cherished and valued.
