We are still looking for feedback from parishioners about our parish's sound system. Your input is invaluable as we explore improvements. We are also in dialogue with the Diocesan chancery office, since technically our building is owned by the Diocese of Hamilton. Thank you for your participation!

Our parish is looking for instrumentalists and singers. Are you interested in the possibility of sharing your musical talents with us as we worship God? Do you play an instrument, or like to sing? We would love to invite local parishioners to get involved. I would be very happy to kindly meet with anyone who is interested. We are also willing to offer training and there is always the possibility of ministering "on rotation" to share the ministry with others. You would also be able to be mentored by those who currently do music ministry already in the parish – we would make it a smooth and easy transition for you. If you are interested at all in sharing any musical talents with our parish, please let me know or contact the parish office! During June, we honour the Month of the Sacred Heart - so a new Sacred Heart of Jesus flag is flying in honor of our Lord's merciful heart. The flag arrived later than we expected, but better late than never! It depicts Jesus lovingly pointing to His Sacred Heart, which is on fire for love of us. Flying such a flag is something sometimes done during this month to help us remember how much the Lord loves all of us. How can your heart be closer to the Sacred Heart of Jesus?


