received visions and messages from Jesus about His mercy. These Church-approved revelations led to the establishment of the Feast of Divine Mercy, celebrated on the Sunday after Easter Sunday which Jesus personally asked for Saint Faustina, canonized by Pope John Paul II in the year 2000, recorded Jesus' requests for the celebration of Divine Mercy Sunday in her diary.

Divine Mercy Sunday is a special day when Catholics honor and celebrate God's infinite mercy and love for humanity. It falls on the second Sunday of the Easter season and serves as a reminder of Jesus' desire for all to trust in His mercy and seek forgiveness for their sins.

In her diary, Saint Faustina documented Jesus' instructions for Divine Mercy Sunday, including the request to receive Holy Communion on this day and to venerate the image of the Divine Mercy, which depicts Jesus with rays of red and white light emanating from His heart, symbolizing the blood and water that flowed from His side on the cross. Jesus asked that Divine Mercy Sunday be the day that ends the Divine Mercy novena, which begins on Good Friday. You can find the Divine Mercy Novena easily online, and we will try to provide copies here as well.

On Divine Mercy Sunday, we are invited to reflect on God's mercy, seek *Peace and Blessings*, forgiveness for our sins, and trust in His boundless love and compassion. It *Fr. Greg* is a time to renew our commitment to living lives of mercy and

compassion toward others, following the example of our merciful Savior, Jesus Christ. Join us in celebrating Divine Mercy Sunday as we rejoice in the unfathomable love of our God, who is rich in mercy. Our plan for Divine Mercy Sunday is currently as follows:

1:30 PM – Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, confessions available 2:45 PM-ish – A short talk on divine mercy by myself (Fr. Greg) 3 PM-ish – Divine Mercy chaplet

3:15 PM-ish - Solemn veneration and incensing of the Divine Mercy image, and benediction

3:30 PM-ish - Confessions begin again as usual before the 4 PM Mass.

Our Lenten Parish Mission this upcoming weekend will feature Fr. Gary Schlack March 16th-19th, who will preach at the weekend Masses as well as Monday and Tuesday evening. His mission homily at all the Sunday Masses will be the same, and he will also preach additional extended homilies on the Eucharist and Confession during the evenings of Monday, March 18th and Tuesday the 19th, at the usual scheduled Mass times (6 PM and 7 PM respectively). March 19th is also the solemnity of St. Joseph and is sure to be a wonderful celebration.
