come in and experience God's mercy. The red light means someone else is in there for now, but when they are finished the next person in line will be able to enter. We are blessed to have many generous parishioners who help is oversee the maintenance of our parish. May God reward them generously a thousand times over!

In consultation with the Diocesan chancery office, we have been asked to return to the use of collection baskets wherever **possible during the Mass.** As a result, our plan is to restore this practice which took place before the pandemic, which many other parishes in the Diocese of Hamilton have already resumed. During the *offertory* of the Mass (when the altar is being prepared for the Eucharist), it is a time when we are called to call to mind all that we want to offer the Lord. We offer Him our love, our prayers, our good works, along with our burdens, struggles, sufferings and Fr. Greg needs. We offer God our hearts and souls, and as part of loving God with all our heart, mind, soul and strength, we seek to offer God

our time, talent and treasure. From the beginning of Christianity, this has also been the time when the Christian community expressed its gratitude to God by means of its sacrificial giving, which was then collected and used for the common good of the community. In many parishes, those offerings are even brought towards the altar area as a sign of the fact that those sacrificial gifts are truly spiritually offered up to the God who cannot be outdone in generosity. We hope to bring this practice back, as we've been directed to, starting this Easter.
