Bishop Crosby has decreed that the Second Sunday of Lent be a time to pray for the victims of sexual abuse. He has published as well, a very meaningful prayer for victims,

Father, since your mercy has been revealed in the tenderness of you Son Jesus Christ, who said to his disciples: "suffer the little children to come unto me". we pray that your Church may be a secure home where all children and vulnerable adults are brought closer to your Beloved Son.

May all those who have been abused physically, emotionally and sexually by your ministers, be respected and accompanied by tangible gestures of justice and reparation so that they may feel healed with the balm of your compassion. We ask this through Christ our Lord.

Heavenly Father, who loves and cares for all of your children, especially the smallest and most vulnerable, we entrust to you the lives of the many children and vulnerable adults, who have been sexually abused, and whose trust and innocence have been destroyed. Help us to hear their cries of pain and to take responsibility for so many broken lives.

We pray that within their communities and families they may be healed, and they may again know peace. Grant this through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who shared our weakness in all things but sin, and lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit for ever and ever. Amen.

LENTEN ROSARY - Join us before daily Mass during Lent until Wednesday, April 5. Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday 8:30a.m, Tuesday 6:30p.m. **Lent** is the yearly celebration by the Church of its corporate conversion in Jesus Christ. During Lent, the liturgy prepares catechumens to celebrate the Paschal Mystery by the various stages of Christian Initiation. It also prepares the faithful for Easter as they recall their Baptism and do penance in preparation for the greatest Feast of the year. (*See GINLY, no. 27*)

Lent has two major purposes: It recalls or prepares for Baptism, and emphasizes a spirit of penance Through forty days of closer attention to God's Word and of more fervent prayer, believers are prepared to celebrate the Paschal Mystery.

Lenten instructions stress these baptismal and penitential themes. During Lent, it is important to teach the social consequences of sin as well as the fact that the heart of the virtue of penance is hatred of sin as an offence against God.

The Church encourages penitential practices that are external and social, reflecting the circumstances of individuals and communities, as we pray and do penance for sinners. (See CSL, nos. 109-110)

What were the three temptations that Jesus overcame in the desert and defeated the devil. We will also look at the scripture verses exchanged between Jesus and the devil and their significance. How Jesus enables us, through the Cross, to reclaim the Garden of Eden that was lost to the devil by Adam and Eve? And much more!


