DEAR PARISHIONERS, you may recall that FROM THE Bishop Crosby has asked me to enlist in a series of PASTOR'S DESK seminars on prayer. The next seminars are scheduled

For that reason, there will be no weekday masses from November 10-19. Our neighbouring pastor, Fr. David Reitzel, has kindly offered to say the Sunday masses on the weekend of November 14/15th. We're blessed to Vision TV broadcasts Mass on Sunday at 8a.m. have a young priest like him in our area.

As pandemic anxiety mounts you might be asked by others; "Are we being punished by God?" It seems clear to me that we are not being punished by God. Indeed, God is our one sure source of strength and consolation in the midst of the trial. However, the matter is complicated when we continue to follow the line of questioning by asking: "if God is not punishing us, then who is?" It seems to me that because our world has strayed from God's protective love, we are prey to the forces of darkness, and it is they who know how to bring distress and suffering. What is most needed in these dark times is the peace and hope that contrite hearts can find in turning back to the light, turning back to God. During the quarantine, I gave a number of teachings on this matter as part of "Thursday afternoon Holy Hours" and they were recorded. I warmly encourage you to re-visit those teachings, and to invite others, especially the young to visit them as well.
