## SOCIAL ACTION

In the previous 3 months DeMazenod Door has seen a 16% increase in the number of meals served vs the same period last year. Total meals served for the last 3 months 2022 was 36,771 vs

31,078 meals served last year or an increase of 62 meals per day. On average that works out to 400 meals/day this year vs 338 meals/day last year. At our parish we are also trying to increase the number of meals we prepare on the 3 and 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesday of each month to meet the increase in demand. Due to your generosity, we have been able to do so and ask you once again to continue to be as generous as you have been. BLUE BOX weekend is next weekend September 17 & 18.

Our two wonderful volunteer cooking groups will be preparing and cooking meals on Wednesday, September  $21^{st}$  and Wednesday September  $28^{th}$  in our parish kitchen. In addition, due to your donations we are hoping once again this year to buy the Thanksgiving turkeys as we have done the past 5 years. Thank you very much for your kindness and caring so deeply for less fortunate who come to DeMazenod Door.
