## Homily Summary – 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of Advent (Year C)

**Theme:** Joy – True joy comes from God, and we experience it by drawing closer to Him.

**Gaudete Sunday Reflection:** Advent is a season of anticipation, and today, we "lighten up" (Rose color) as we rejoice in the coming of Christ, the source of true joy. This ties into the upcoming Jubilee Year of Hope, a Church-wide invitation to renew our spiritual lives, seek reconciliation, and grow closer to God. Special celebrations, including holy doors and prayers, will help deepen this joy.

**Personal Story:** Fr. Greg shared a moving encounter from a medical appointment, where a man named Peron told him about a near-death experience that led to his conversion from Hinduism to Christianity. Peron described a place of perfect joy, inspiring him to turn his life around and center it on Christ. His story emphasizes the profound joy God offers when we seek Him.

**Message of Hope:** True joy is not merely an emotion but a spiritual gift that flows from a close relationship with God. Through prayer, scripture, and living by faith, we experience a foretaste of Heaven's joy. God's joy is available even amidst hardships, and He invites us to seek His comfort and peace, especially during the struggles of the season.

**Practical Application:** Parishioners are encouraged to honor loved ones through Christmas poinsettias, reminding us of hope and the joy found in God's promises. Everyone is invited to reflect on whether they find their joy in the Lord and open their hearts to His transformative peace.

**God gives us peace, love, rest and joy:** St. Augustine's quote, "Our hearts are restless until they rest in you, O God," captures the essence of today's message. God offers spiritual joy and peace to sustain us through life's challenges. Let's welcome Christ with open hearts as we await the ultimate joy of eternal life.

## **Rap Summary:**

Gaudete Sunday says we find our Joy in the Lord, He is coming soon, and by Him we're adored. May we open hearts in welcome to our joy-giving friend, Who one day wants to take us where the joy never ends.

Jesus receive *our* hearts as *our* gift to *you*. We give you our permission to bring joy how you do. Lord Jesus, our Hope, you showed us many great feats, So do as you have said, and make our joy complete.
