


# Southside San Antonio Wellness District and Stroke Rehabilitation Clinic


### **Health Inequity in Southside San Antonio**



Southside San Antonio suffers from a morbidity rate significantly higher than wealther northern San Antonio, with southside residents having 10-15 fewer years of life expectancy than areas a few miles away.

Despite urban density and proximity to downtown, southside residents have no immediate access to medical services, pharmacies, or nutritional resources.


















#### Form Focused on Optimized Walking Distance and Views

Research shows that shorter distances between patient rooms and therapy or dining increases patient independence and leads to shorter recover times.




### **Roof Connects to Natural Rhythms and Wayfinding**

A timber and tensil frame roof provide diffuse light and shading from intense sun. Shadow play from the lattice pattern help patients connect to natural circadiam rhythms while the slits between the fins highlight the main circulation paths from the entrance to the sensory garden in the back.


