## TO ALL UNIT OWNERS:

Before attempting to have any major work done in your unit, you must comply with the following:

- 1. The Board must be notified before any major work begins.
- 2. The Contractor must be licensed and insured. The building must received a copy of the insurance naming the owner as well as Greenbrier A Association as additional insured, in addition to a copy of the license. Any major changes required a permit.
- 3. DO NOT REMOVE ANY INTERIOR WALLS.
- 4. If you are changing your windows or door, you must comply with code, i.e. hurricane impact. Windows and doors need to have a permit.
- 5. If you are enclosing or changing your patio, it must meet code as well.

## PURCHASERS OF GREENBRIER A CONDOMINIUM UNIT

This is notification that you are aware of the following By-Laws in effect for Greenbrier A Condominium Association.

- 1. Purchaser of a condo in Greenbrier A must own the unit for one year before it can be resold. Exceptions are death, divorce or a proven hardship of the unit owner or owners. Hardship to be approved by the Board of Directors.
- 2. No Animal or Pets of any kind shall be kept in any unit of Greenbrier A except small fish in a tank and small bird in cage.
- 3. Limit ownership to only one unit per owner within building of Greenbrier A Condominium Association.
- 4. No Rentals are permitted.
- 5. Must show proof of Homeowner Insurance, minimum \$35,000.00 per Fl. Statue.
- 6. No Washer or Dryer allowed in Units.
