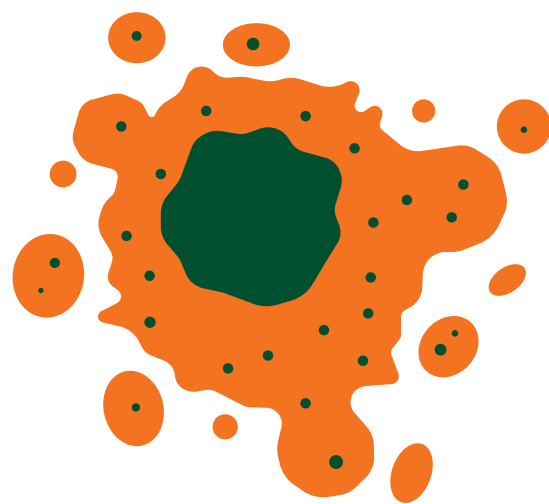

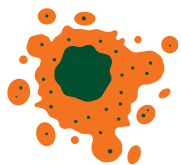

DESCRIPTION

In the United States, the incidence of skin cancer surpasses all other cancers combined. This course offers cutting edge updates on the treatment of complex skin cancers including melanoma, advanced squamous cell carcinoma, and high risks basal cell carcinomas. The course will utilize a combination of high impact lectures and case presentations to provide attendees with updates on novel therapeutics and recent advances in treatments. During the multi-disciplinary panels, complex skin malignancies will be presented and discussed in a tumor board style with experts from dermatology, head and neck surgery, medical oncology, surgical oncology, ophthalmic oncology, plastic surgery, pathology, and radiation oncology.

OBJECTIVES

1. Define characteristics of skin cancers that require multidisciplinary treatment.
2. Review role of biological therapy in the treatment of advanced skin cancer.
3. Discuss newly approved therapies for high risk and advanced skin cancers.
4. Assess the role and variety of radiotherapeutic approaches to complex skin cancer.
5. Review novel approaches to optimize surgical treatment of advanced skin cancers.

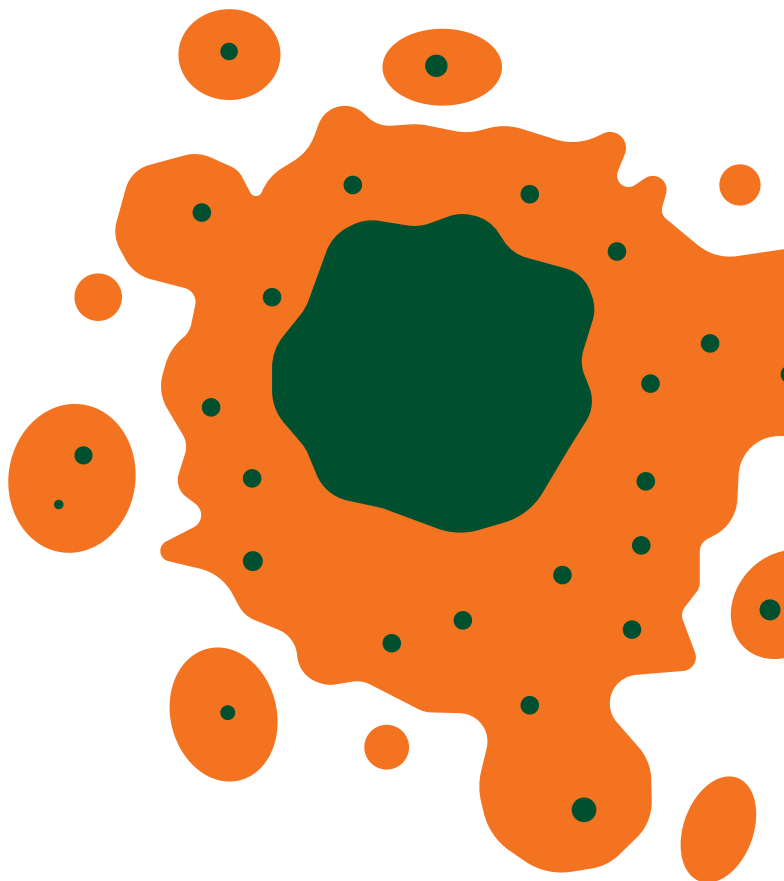
