The within described puppy is in good health, to the best of the Seller's knowledge at the time of sale. The puppy has received the necessary age appropriate vaccinations and deworming and has been examined by our licensed Vet from Honey Hill Animal Hospital in Searcy, AR. This included a fecal and physical exam.

Purchase Agreement :

1. In the event the buyer finds they are unable to keep the puppy any longer, the puppy MUST be returned to the breeder immediately and the breeder will rehome the dog. Said puppy may not be rehomed for any reason, it MUST be returned to the seller.
2. In the event of the above mentioned situation, all costs associated with the return of the puppy to the breeder are to be of the buyer's responsibility.
3. The rehoming fee will be given to the original buyer when the dog is rehomed. This is to ensure that the puppy will not go to a backyard breeder, animal shelter, or

puppy mill and the breeder can screen the new home and to make sure the new owner is ready and able to raise the dog. The rehoming fee will be subject to the breeders discretion.

4. After the puppy is returned to the breeder, all costs associated are the responsibility of the former buyer, therefore any costs in regard to the puppy after its return to the breeder, will be deducted from the refund of the puppy.
5. The puppy is a PET ONLY.
6. We reserve the right to terminate this sale at any time. In the event this happens, the deposit will be refunded to the buyer in the same form of payment as the deposit was received.
7. The purchase price of the puppy must be paid in full upon pickup day. Final payment is to be made in the form of cash.

Seller's Obligations:

1. Seller extends a guarantee against fatal viruses for 72 hours. This includes Distemper, Parvo, and Corona. It does NOT include Coccidia, Giardia, or Kennel Cough. These are common ailments in puppies and we cannot provide a guarantee against them.
2. Seller extends a genetic guarantee on the above described puppy until such time as puppy reaches 12 months or one (1) year of age. Genetic disorders are defined as any life threatening condition and are limited to the following: kidney, heart, pancreas, and liver.
3. In the event that the above described puppy is diagnosed with a fatal virus, (as outlined in paragraph 1) or a genetic disorder, (as outlined in paragraph 2) and Buyer can provide a diagnosing veterinarians report, then, and in that event, the Buyer may return the puppy to the seller at Buyers expense. Seller shall provide Buyer a puppy of equivalent value chosen by the Seller. If a puppy of equivalent value is not available at that time , one will be provided from a future litter or a refund will be given.

Buyer's Acknowledgments and Obligations: (initial after reading and agreeing to conditions set forth)

Buyer acknowledges that the puppy is not guaranteed with respect to the following:

1. Internal or external parasites, (coccidiosis, roundworms, hookworms, giardia, etc.) or external parasites as they are common in dogs and puppies.
2. Umbilical hernias, hypoglycemia, skin allergies, under or over bites.
3. Health issues arising from trauma, abuse, or failure to maintain general health care of this dog/puppy.
4. For show, breeding, adult size, coat type, color, or temperament.
5. Buyer shall have the puppy examined by a licensed veterinarian within five (5) business days of pick-up. If the veterinarian finds a genetic defect that will be LIFE THREATENING and will affect the day to day life of the puppy Buyer may exchange said puppy for one of the same breed, gender, and value. Said puppy shall be selected by Seller and shall be provided as soon as a puppy becomes available. If no puppy is available a refund may be issued. In the event as described above, the puppy must be returned to the seller immediately at the expense of the Buyer.
6. Buyer agrees to provide routine preventative health care including, but not limited to, inoculations, parasite control, preventative medications, skin allergies and any treatment for any condition which is not genetic as defined above. Buyer further acknowledges that Seller will not be responsible to pay any medical expenses once Buyer takes possession of the puppy.
7. The Buyer acknowledges that they have been fully instructed by the Seller NOT to take the puppy to public places until the puppy has received its final round of vaccinations. This is for the health of our puppy to avoid all areas where an unvaccinated or infected dog may have been exposed to an illness/bacterial/fungus causing, Parvo, Giardia, Clostridia, Coccidia, and Kennel Cough, etc. These are highly contagious and are easily passed to your puppy from other animals or the environment. Because of the extremely contagious nature of these illnesses, they cannot be guaranteed after the pup has left Seller's premises. In case of an unforeseen death of said puppy, a necropsy must be performed at the Buyer's expense to determine cause of death and a copy of results must be provided to the Seller for warranty to be honored.

Health Guarantee:

1. The puppy is guaranteed to be in good health at the time of sale and will have been vet checked at the age of six to seven weeks.
2. The puppy will be up to date on vaccination and worming up until it is time to come home.
3. The puppy must be vet checked within five (5) business days of pick-up, and documentation of said vet check must be provided to the breeder. Failure to provide proof that the puppy was vet checked will void the health guarantee.
4. If within five (5) business days, a licensed vet finds the puppy to have a genetic defect that will be LIFE THREATENING and will affect the day to day life of the puppy, the Buyer may exchange said puppy for one of the same breed, gender, and value. Said puppy shall be selected by the Seller and shall be provided a puppy of equal value as soon as one becomes available, or a refund will be issued if none are available.
5. We guarantee the health of our puppies free from life threatening genetic diseases for one year. Proof must be provided by two licensed veterinarians with documentation to show that it is a genetic life threatening disease. This guarantee does not include minor illnesses and health issues such as colds, allergies, internal or external parasites, coccidia, giardia, umbilical hernias or any conditions caused by lack of proper care of the puppy.

Spay and Neuter Contract:

1. The Buyer agrees that the puppy is being purchased as PET ONLY and is not to be bred. Buyer agrees to have the puppy spayed/neutered and provide proof of such to the Seller by nine (9) months of age.
2. Proof of this, in the form of a Certificate of Spay/Neuter from the veterinarian, must be forwarded to the Seller by the time the puppy reaches nine (9) months of age.
3. If the Seller does not receive this documentation within this time, the Buyer will pay the Seller \$3,000 for full breeding rights.

Other Obligations/Acknowledgements/Agreements:

1. In the event of a legal dispute, legal jurisdiction shall be with Cleburne County, Arkansas. Should the Seller prevail in any civil action, the Buyer will be responsible for Seller's attorney fees.
2. The Buyer acknowledges that the Seller has fulfilled all terms of this contract and Buyer agrees unequivocally that the Buyer SHALL NOT make any representation to the contrary, or otherwise, to any person, or entity, verbally, in written correspondence, or in any social or news media (Internet, Facebook, Twitter, television, or print media, etc.)
3. This contract shall NOT be interpreted against the Drafter.
4. By signing below, Buyer acknowledges that he or she has read and reviewed the terms of this agreement as set forth, and this written contract constitutes the entire agreement regarding the health, condition, care and loss of the puppy between the Buyer and that NO other representations, either oral or written have been made regarding the described dog/puppy, and that the Buyer has received a copy of this form. The puppy MUST be seen by a Certified Licensed Veterinarian within five (5) business days for the warranty to be valid. A copy of the examination MUST be mailed or emailed within three (3) days of the examination. Failure to do so will VOID the one year health guarantee as described above.
4. Any warranties /guarantees expressed herein are non-transferable.
