Year 9 subject choice

During the summer term, our students will be offered Curriculum guidance and Career advice and guidance in order to choose the appropriate subject and qualifications for their potential careers aspirations.

Post 16 Education

In Year 11 all students will need to think about what they want to do after their end of KS4 studies. They must consider if they want to continue in full time education, apply for an apprenticeship or look for work and training. Starting at the end of year 10 students will be given support to help them make informed decisions.
