





All of the links in this guide were checked and working as of March 2020.














1. Down on the farm

Ever wondered where milk comes from? Or cheese? Take a trip down to the farm and find out! Just click here: <u>Virtual Farm Walk</u>




Did you enjoy your visit to the farm? Things you could do now:

Have a look around the home of the President of the United States of America - the White House in Washington D.C. Just click here: The White House




Did you enjoy your visit to the White House? Things you could do now:

Explore the most famous gardens in France - The Gardens of Versailles - the pride and joy of King Louis XIV. Just click here: The Gardens of Versailles




Did you enjoy your visit to the Gardens of Versailles? Things you could do now:

Head over to China to see one of the Wonders of the World! It is over 2000 years old and 3000 miles long. Just click here: The Great Wall of China




Did you enjoy your visit to The Great Wall of China? Things you could do now:

Join David Attenborough to explore this reef off the coast of Australia from the comfort of a submarine. Just click here: The Great Barrier Reef




Did you enjoy your visit to The Great Barrier Reef? Things you could do now:

Take a trip around the galleries of the Louvre. See the Egyptian artefacts and look around its ancient foundations. Just click here: The Louvre




Did you enjoy your visit to the Louvre? Things you could do now:

Ever wondered what the Queen's home looks like? Step inside Buckingham Palace and find out! Just click here: Buckingham Palace




Did you enjoy your visit to Buckingham Palace? Things you could do now:




Did you enjoy your visit to Paignton Zoo? Things you could do now:

Towering over the city of Athens, the Acropolis is an incredible feat of architecture. Explore these amazing ruins here: <u>The Acropolis</u>




Did you enjoy your visit to the Acropolis? Things you could do now:

Take a worldwide journey under the sea from British Coasts to the Atlantic Ocean, seeing sharks, rays and fish. Click here: The National Marine Aquarium




Did you enjoy your visit to the National Marine Aquarium? Things you could do now:

Join Tim Peake as he guides us around the International Space Station as it orbits the Earth. Click here: <u>The ISS</u>




Did you enjoy your visit to the ISS? Things you could do now:

This is the most visited urban park in the USA. It is located in Manhattan in New York and has lakes, ponds and playgrounds. Just click here: Central Park




Did you enjoy your visit to Central Park? Things you could do now:

Travel back in time to visit this incredible feat of engineering - a 40 foot high treasury in the ancient city of Petra. Just click here: Petra




Did you enjoy your visit to Petra? Things you could do now:

Visit the ruins of an ancient Inca Empire in the mountains of Peru. Can you find the alpacas? Just click here: Machu Picchu




Did you enjoy your visit to Machu Picchu? Things you could do now:

Marvel at the incredible ceiling painted by Michelangelo, in this chapel within the Vatican. Just click here: <u>The Sistine Chapel</u>




Did you enjoy your visit to the Sistine Chapel? Things you could do now:

Another wonder of the world, this marble mausoleum is the best-known landmark in India. Just click here: The Taj Mahal




Did you enjoy your visit to the Taj Mahal? Things you could do now:

Thanks to technology, you can see what this Cambodian Buddhist temple would have been like in the 12th century. Just click here: Angkor Wat




Did you enjoy your visit to Angkor Wat? Things you could do now:

From the ruins of Pompeii to the canals of Venice to the Leaning Tower of Pisa, you can visit them all! Just click here: Italy



This is the biggest occupied castle in the world and where the Queen usually spends her weekends! Just click here: Windsor Castle




Did you enjoy your visit to Windsor Castle? Things you could do now:

Situated on the banks of the River Avon, this medieval marvel is simply jaw-dropping! Just click here: <u>Warwick Castle</u>




Did you enjoy your visit to Warwick Castle? Things you could do now:

Everyone loves pandas! Take a trip over to China and see what the panda is up to today or scroll back for highlights! Just click here: Gengda Valley




Did you enjoy your visit to Gengda Valley? Things you could do now:

No human being has ever been to Mars, but thanks to robot technology from NASA, you can still have a look around the red planet! Just click here: Mars




Did you enjoy your visit to Mars? Things you could do now:

Join scientists as they track polar bears across the Arctic tundra! Find out what they do all day. Just click here: Arctic Tundra




Did you enjoy your visit to the Arctic Tundra? Things you could do now:






Did you enjoy your visit to the German Oceanographic Museum? Things you could do now:

Take a look around the Allianz Stadium in Turin, Italy - home of Juventus, one of the most famous football clubs. Just click here: Allianz Stadium




Did you enjoy your visit to the Allianz Stadium? Things you could do now:

Explore the many halls of this fascinating museum in London. Transport, science fiction and materials - it's all here! Just click here: Science Museum




Did you enjoy your visit to the Science Museum? Things you could do now:

Explore the world's largest cave - Son Doong in Vietnam! Cross the underground river as you pass giant stalagmites! Just click here: Son Doong



Ornate wooden carvings and magnificent stone features can be seen throughout this 1440 year old building! Just click here: Canterbury Cathedral




Did you enjoy your visit to Canterbury Cathedral? Things you could do now:
