We exist to spread the good news of Jesus Christ by meeting the spiritual and physical needs of people throughout all the earth.

Save Pakistan

All The Earth's primary ministry focus is to support the work of our Christian partners at Save Pakistan. Together with them, enslaved people are rescued from the harsh conditions of the brick factories in Pakistan.

In Pakistan, a poor person who experiences a life financial emergency has no alternative other than to borrow money at an exorbitant interest rate. To pay off the loan they are forced to work at a local brick factory. Conditions are horrendous and the loan is impossible to pay off. It becomes a generational problem as children inherit their parent's debt.

Our goal is to free as many enslaved children and adults as possible by paying off their debt and providing support as they gain their independence.

THE HIGHLIGHTS

- We raised enough support to provide Pastor H a salary of \$1,000 a month! This provides for his family, his church, and their slave ministry, which ministers in 30 brick factories throughout Pakistan.
- We were blessed to pay the debts of two slaves, bringing them to freedom: 13-year-old Kainat and 11-year-old Pari.

Stories of Freedom

- Pari: 11-year-old Pari lost her father when she was 2. Her mother tried to support the two of them but was unable to. A year after her father's death her mother took them to the local brick factory. At 11, her mother died in the factory. Soon after her mother's sister stepped to care for Pari if Save Pakistan would pay her debt of \$550 to get her out. God provided, she is free now.



"Today I want to share with you wonderful news that God makes it possible for us to pay the debt of Pari and freed her from the hell of the slavery. Praise God. We are so much thankful to All The Earth Ministries who support us for the freedom of Pari. May God Bless more all of you who support us prayerfully and financially."

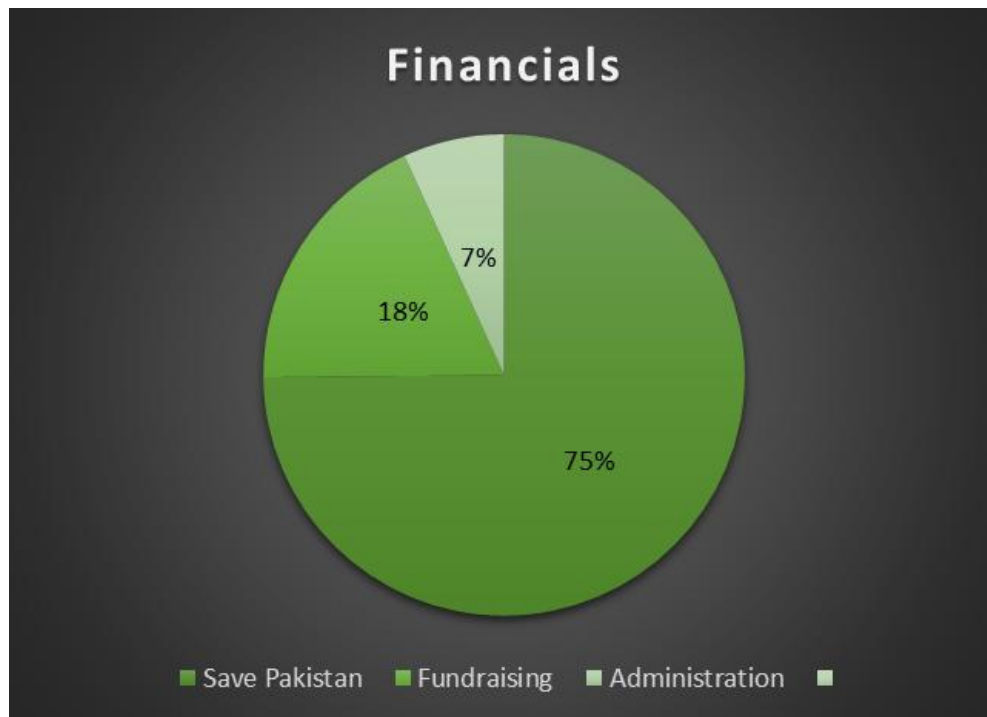
- Kainat: When Kainat was 10 years' old her father died from alcoholism. Her and her mother went to work for the local slave factory to survive. Two years later her mother passed, leaving 12-year-old Kainat alone in the factory. Sincer her passing her aunt- her mother's sister-has wanted to get Kainat out of the factory and has been willing to take care of her. A year later that because a reality as the Lord provided the money to pay the debt. 13-year-old Kainat has been set free.

Her \$950 debt was paid for by Missy Jean Jessop's precious grandmother, Norma Jean Carpenter. Missy recalls "she pulled me aside at Thanksgiving and said 'I want to free a little girl in Pakistan in memory of Grandpa Don and Tony.' Grampa Don Carpenter, passed in March 2025, and Missy's step-father, Tony Petty, passed in July 2023. Normally, Grandpa Don and Grandma Jeannie send checks to all their grandkids with a little money for Christmas. This year she decided to use that money for freedom in honor of these men and as an example to her grandchildren.

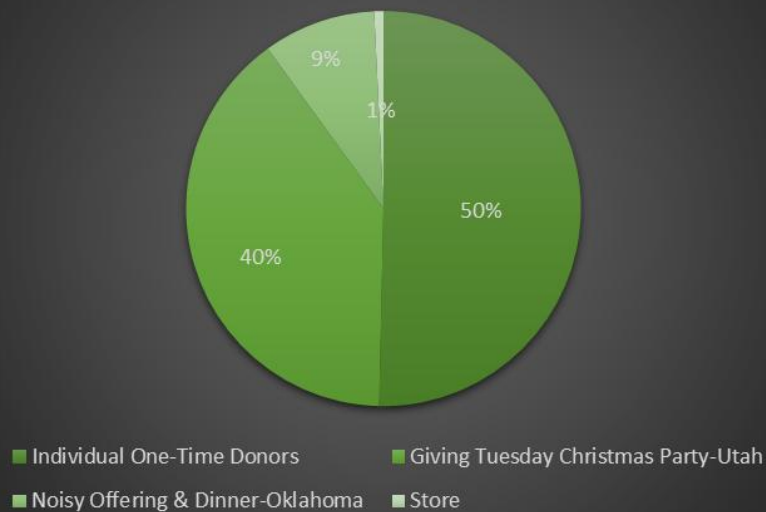
