- Officially became YALD in 2012.
- Achieved 501(c)(3) nonprofit status in 2014.
- "YALD" has come to mean giving your all — on and off the field. It's how we approach every season.
- YALD's home field in Highbridge Park isn't just a place for touchdowns — it sits on a historic ridge used during the Revolutionary War and neighbors NYC's oldest standing bridge: the High Bridge, built in 1848!
- Alumni now return as coaches, mentors, and role models.
