Entry Fees:

Youth & Open Shows--\$8.00 per goat, per class, per show

Showmanship: \$5.00

Supplies: Shavings will be available for purchase. There will be vendors on-site.

Uniforms: All 4H, FFA, or Grange members are to wear proper uniforms during the youth show only. If not affiliated, independent showman must wear blue jeans and collared shirt.

Pen Fees: \$10.00 per pen. Pens are 4 x 8. No bedding is provided. Shavings only please.

The Fairgrounds will be doing the pen cleaning for us!! Pens will be assigned and marked for your convenience. There will also be the area directly North of the show ring that you can show out of your

trailer. First come, first serve.

Bring tarps/covers and/or plastic netting for baby goats as they can get out of pens.

Prospect Wether Class: The purpose of the class is for exhibitors to show bucklings that are obviously going to be wethers, but have chosen not to castrate them at an early age. This class will be the first wether class judged at each show. However, they will not compete for Best Wether and Reserve Best Wether.

Master Champion: The Master Champion competition will be offered at the beginning of the Doe & Buck Open Shows. There must be three PGCH does/bucks for each competition. If you enter your animal and then are unable to bring it, please contact the Show Chair immediately so they can contact other owners in the event the show will not meet the required number. Please register your MCH on the entry form, but pay at the show.

Health Check: Only healthy animals allowed on fairgrounds. Animals with obvious signs of illness (runny noses, eyes, cough) or parasites (scratching or diarrhea) will be requested to leave. No refund on entry fees.

N.P.G.A. RULES TO GOVERN. N.P.G.A. SANCTIONED. Only animals with original registration papers or registration papers with transfers less than ninety (90) days will be allowed to show.

N.P.G.A. RULES:

- 1. It is the ultimate responsibility of the exhibitor that the exhibitor's goat(s) is/are entered and shown in the correct age class and division. (Rule B3a).
- 2. Exhibitors shall not show any doe or buck in an N.P.G.A sanctioned show with the herd name(s) of the judge who is judging the show. This does not apply to wethers or unregistered classes or sanctioned 4-H/Youth shows. (Rule B3b).
- 3. NPGA requires that all animals 6 months of age or older must have a legible tattoo and/or microchip prior to being shown. (Rule C4)
- 4. Although the show chair, secretary, or designee will check the registration papers prior to the goat being shown to ensure that each goat has been entered in the correct age class and division, it is the ultimate responsibility of the exhibitor that the exhibitor's goat(s) is/are entered and shown in the correct class and division.

Original Registration Papers Need To Be Present At The Show.

Dogs: <u>NO</u> dogs are allowed in the goat barn or surrounding area at any time (except service dogs)! Please keep dogs away from show ring.

Silent Auction: There will be Silent Auctions during the shows with all proceeds going to G.S.P.G.A. Any donations will be *greatly* appreciated. Please tape your name or business card to your donations so we know who to thank!

Awards: Ribbons are awarded for 1st thru 5th places in the Youth Show. NPGA Rosette Ribbons are awarded to all Champions. Additional prizes will be awarded as well.

Meals: There will be food vendors with (breakfast, lunch, dinner & snacks) and drinks for sale.

Directions to Porterville Fairgrounds:

From the 99--Take Exit #76 -190/Porterville/Springville; Travel east on Hwy 190 to Hwy 65 South; Turn right (south towards Bakersfield) at Hwy 65; From Hwy 65 turn right (west) at Teapot Dome; Travel 2 miles to PORTERVILLE FAIR on the right; Please follow the LIVESTOCK ENTRANCE signs for the show.
