

MAXIMUM DIMENSIONS FOR YOUR CARRY-ON LUGGAGE BY DOMESTIC AIRLINE:

United Airlines	9 inches x 14 inches x 22 inches (22 cm x 35 cm x 56 cm), including handles and wheels. (may not exceed 45 linear inches)
American Airlines	22 inches x 14 inches x 9 inches / 23 x 36 x 56 centimeters (including handles and wheels) (may not exceed 45 linear inches)
Southwest Airlines	10 inches x 16 inches x 24 inches (may not exceed 50 linear inches)
Alaska Airlines	24 inches x 10 inches x 17 inches (61cm x 25cm x 43cm), including wheels and handles (may not exceed 51 linear inches)

Delta Airlines	22 inches x 14 inches x 9 inches (56 x 35 x 23 cm) (Carry-on bags may not exceed 45 linear inches in combined length x width x height)
JetBlue	22 inches x 14 inches x 9 inches, including wheels/handles (may not exceed 50 linear inches)
Hawaiian Airlines	9 inches x 14 inches x 22 inches (may not exceed 45 linear inches) Weight limit of 25 lbs per passenger (the only airline on the list with a weight limit for carry-ons)
Spirit Airlines	22 inches x 18 inches x 10 inches (may not exceed 50 linear inches)
Virgin America	24 inches x 16 inches x 10 inches (may not exceed 50 linear inches)
Allegiant Airlines	22 inches x 14 inches x 9 inches (may not exceed 45 linear inches)

Horizon Air	24 inches x 10 inches x 17 inches (61cm x 25cm x 43cm), including wheels and handles (may not exceed 51 linear inches)
Frontier Airlines	24 inches x 16 inches x 10 inches (may not exceed 50 linear inches)
Sun Country	24 inches x 16 inches x 11 inches (may not exceed 51 linear inches)

Here are the maximum carry on size and weight restrictions for a select number of international airlines:

Air France	21.7 inches x 13.8 inches x 9.9 inches (carry on and personal item may not exceed 12 pounds combined)
KLM Royal Dutch Airline	21.5 inches x 13.5 inches x 10 inches
Emirates	For economy class 1 bag 22 inches x 15 inches x 8 inches (may not exceed 15 pounds) For first class one briefcase at 8 inches x 14 inches x 8 inches and either a handbag at 22 inches x 15 inches x 8 inches or a garment bag that may not exceed 8 inches thick w

Qatar Airways	18 inches x 15 inches x 10 inches (may not exceed 15 pounds)
Singapore Airlines	45.2 linear inches (may not exceed 15.4 pounds)
Volaris	22.4 inches x 15.7 inches x 12.9 inches (may not exceed 15.4 pounds)
Cathay Pacific	22 inches x 14 inches x 9 inches (may not exceed 15 pounds)
Aeromexico	22 inches x 14 inches x 8 inches (may not exceed 22 pounds)
Air Canada	21.5 inches x 15.5 inches x 9 inches

How To Measure Your Carry On Luggage

Knowing the dimensions you can bring on is one thing, but it won't help if you don't know how airlines measure luggage. It is important to note that both handles and wheels are included in the measurement. The airline will measure your luggage from the contact point with the ground, whether that's the wheels or the bottom of the bag, to the highest point (which may be a handle, zipper, etc).

- 1. Height:** measure your luggage from the contact point with the ground, whether that's the wheels or the bottom of the bag, to the highest point (which may be a handle, zipper, etc).
- 2. Width:** Lay it on its side and measure from the ground to the top point to find the width (remember to include straps, handles, and side pockets)
- 3. Depth:** Lay the suitcase on the front or back and repeat to find the depth.
- 4. Math:** Add them together to find the total linear inches – Most airlines have a maximum of 45 to 51 linear inches. If your luggage exceeds this, you may have to check it.
