Portraiture:

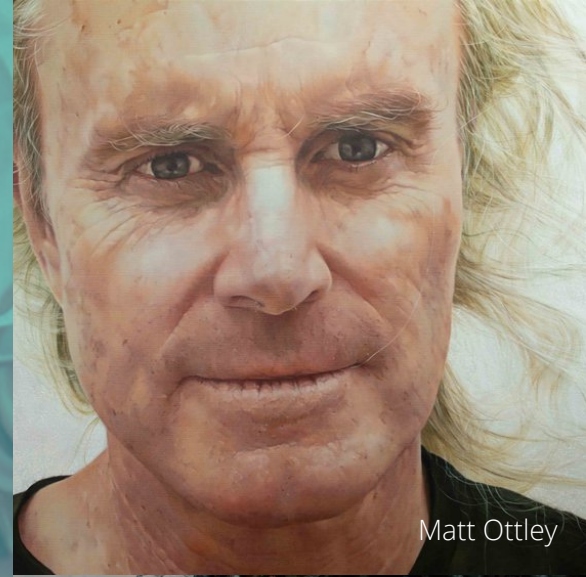

Your memoir will be beautifully designed and produced by publisher Carina Hoang and her team of professionals – with your portrait on the cover (optional).



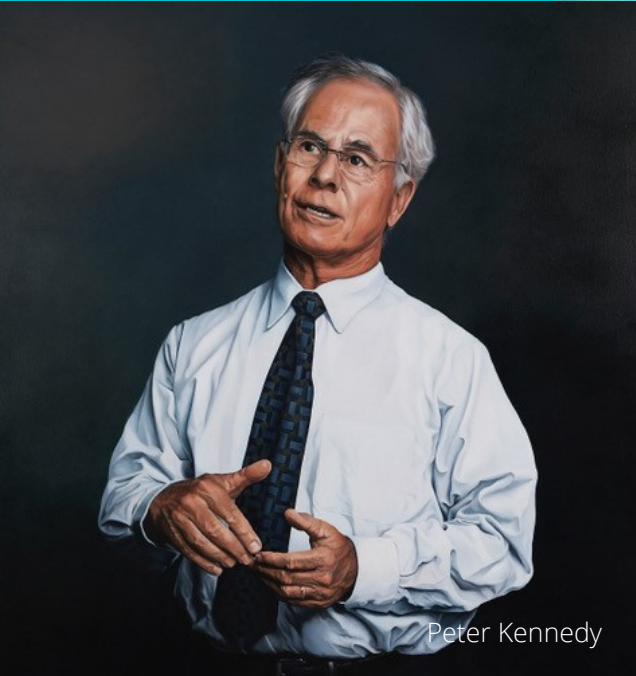

ABOUT LIVING LEGACIES:

Living Legacies was initially conceptualised when artist Jana Vodesil-Baruffi set herself the challenge of painting the portraits of 50 of Western Australia's most inspiring women in just one year. This collection is titled *Permanent Impressions* and has been hailed as one of the largest portraiture collections by a single artist.

It was followed by a book of the same name featuring Jana's portraits, written by author Carmen Jenner and published by Carina Hoang Communications. *Permanent Impressions: a salute to contemporary heroines* received a bronze IPPY Award in the Independent Book Publishers awards in New York City for Best Non-fiction in the Australia/NZ region.

After the success of the *Permanent Impressions* project, the team have continued to successfully collaborate on projects. In 2021, they officially launched Living Legacies to honour the legacies of inspirational individuals.

Jana Vodesil-Baruffi



Renowned for her artistic versatility ranging from Fantastic Realism to the Realism of portraiture and landscapes, Jana has an impressively large body of work. Jana's accolades are plentiful and she is a six-time finalist and winner of The Lester Prize, formerly named the Black Swan Prize for Portraiture. In 2017, Jana won the portraiture award for her moving and confronting portrait of a young woman with an eating disorder titled *Black Swan*, and in 2021, she was nominated for her portrait of former Olympian Eric Pearce titled *Life Well Lived*. Carmen Jenner



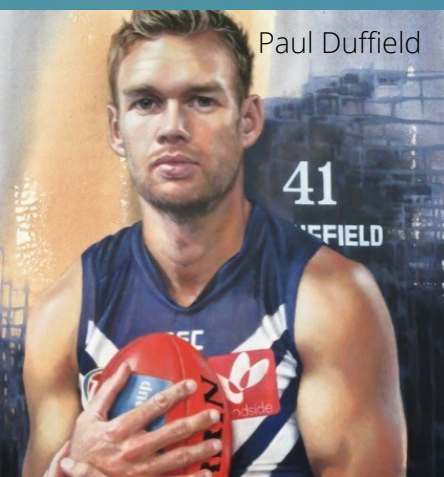

Carina Hoang

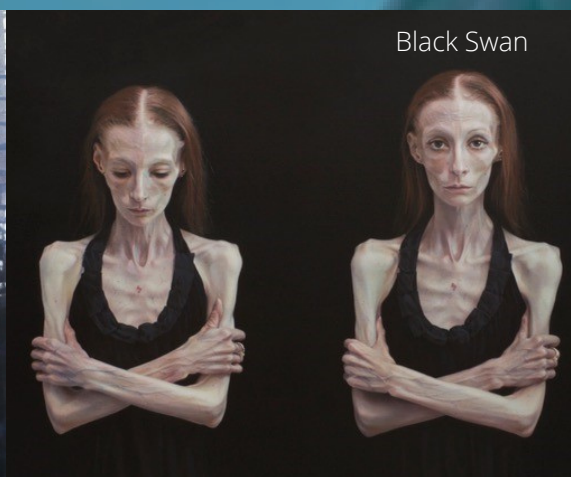


Carina Hoang is an award-winning author and publisher and is renowned for her book *Boat People: Personal Stories from the Vietnamese Exodus 1975 - 1996*, sharing the harrowing stories of Vietnamese refugees, including her own journey. In 2012, *Boat People* won a silver medal in the New York City IPPY Book Publishers Awards for the Australia and New Zealand region in the Best Non-fiction category. This was the first of many titles Carina has produced and published, including two more gold and bronze IPPY medals for Australia/NZ and Europe Best Non-fiction in 2014 and 2019. Carina is a sought-after public speaker, an Ambassador for Australia for UNHCR and an actress.
