

Parking (plan below)

All parking is private. There are strictly only 2 parking spaces that are owned and available to use. They are facing the sea to the right-hand side of the bike shelter. There are 4 spaces on the row, so please park considerately to allow adequate space for the other owners.



Waste Disposal

House must be cleared of all rubbish and bins emptied on checkout.

Conwy Council is very proactive in the recycling of waste. At the entrance Green Boxes stacked on top one each other marked '4'. These are for the recycling of glass, paper, plastic and metal. There is another waste disposal box for food. The large black bin is strictly only for non-recyclable waste.

Directions

From Chester leave the A55 at junction 21 signposted Rhos on Sea. Follow the signs to Rhos on Sea crossing back over the A55 and continue to the roundabout. At the roundabout take the fourth exit onto Whitehall Road (signposted Promenade). Follow the road to the end where Aberhod Cove can be found on the left just before the T junction with the Promenade. From Bangor leave the A55 at junction 21 signposted Rhos on Sea. At the traffic lights bear left and continue to the roundabout. At the roundabout take the fourth exit onto Whitehall Road (signposted Promenade). Follow the road to the end where Aberhod Cove can be found on the left just before the T junction with the Promenade.

Check in information

Enter the code and pull down the silver lever, remove from wall.

Closest Cash Machine

Turn left out of the property, take the first left after the Cayley Flyer, cross the road to take the next right. Cash machine located on the right-hand side.

Things to do:

- 1. Zip World, it has 3 sites. You can book online. Around 25 mins away.
- 2. Grand Puppet Circus Puppet Theatre behind the house.
- 3. Welsh Mountain Zoo in Colwyn Bay.
- 4. Greenwood Family Park on Anglesey.
- 5. Surf Snowdonia surfing lessons.
- 6. Kayak hire Colwyn Bay Watersports Centre.
- 7. Newborough Forest Park, Anglesey, LL61 6SG There's a walking trail & a bike quest plus it's at the beach. £5 entry per car
- 8. Take the tram from Llandudno up the Great Orme plus cable cars.
- 9. The Arcades on the pier in Llandudno.
- 10. SC2 Rhyl, the new waterpark & Tag Active. Not been there yet it only opened on 5th April.
- 11. Mini Golf at Rhos Fynach pub. A walk away turn left out of the house follow along the promenade.
- 12. Cineworld Llandudno Junction.
- 13. The Tides Cafe at the Beach caravan park. It's 5 miles to cycle there, head towards Rhyl.
- 14. Boat trip to Puffin Island. You will see seals, puffins & sometimes dolphins. It goes from Beaumaris Pier on Anglesey if you do the 90 minute cruise with Seacoast Safaris it's £10.95 for adults & £7.95 for children. There is another fast boat called rib ride which is around £25 each
- 15. The Dutch Pancake House at Conwy Water Gardens.
