


STOP OVERSIZED SOLAR



Romney Marsh farm land is some of the best land for food production in the country. Yet up to 5 proposed super-sized renewable energy schemes threaten to smother the land in panels and battery containers as far as the eye can see.

Oversized solar panels and lithium ion batteries could damage our environment irreversibly and increase flood risks.

Storage batteries are a major fire risk. Battery fires cannot be put out with water and can cause potentially fatal gas emissions.



We share Romney Marsh with rare and sensitive species of wildlife and plants that live alongside farming.

Replacing our open green spaces with glass and metal, and surrounding our drainage dykes with industrial infrastructure will damage our rich biodiversity, taking possibly decades to re-establish.

Will wildlife, nature lovers and leisure seekers continue to visit Romney Marsh with glass and metal everywhere?
