- 12. Consider and approve bid from Patterson Service to assist in water leak on W. Main St involving a fire hydrant.
 - Beth stated that this leak it near at least 3 fiber optic lines and very close to Hwy 69 and a utility pole. If Patterson does the work, the liability falls to them.
 - Allen Polk made a motion to approve bid from Patterson Service to assist in water leak on W. Main St. Roger Goodwin seconded the motion, motion carried 4-0.
- 13. Consider and approve bid for the relocation of electrical line at Well #1.
 - Bill Richtermeyer made a motion to approve a bid not to exceed \$10,000.00 with the Mayor's approval. Roger Goodwin seconded the motion, motion carried 4-0.
- 14. Consider and approve the repairs to the Carter Lift Station on FM 1897.
